<u>Note</u> – The points to be covered in the Statutory Declaration should be:

- 1. When you took possession of the dog;
- 2. How you came to be in possession of the dog, for example:
 - (a) When you purchased the dog, from whom you bought it, and how much you paid for it. You should attach a copy of any document(s) you have providing proof of purchase e.g. a receipt for the purchase price signed by the registered owner; or
 - (b) If the dog was given to you as a gift, when that happened, who actually gave you the dog, and what were the circumstances of the gift – e.g. as a birthday present, given to you because the owner was going away etc.;
- 3. Where you know the address of the registered owner, what attempts you have made to have the registered owner sign a Transfer to you. Please attach copies of any correspondence between yourself and the registered owner in that regard; and
- 4. If you do not know the address of the registered owner, why that is e.g. because they have gone overseas, have left their address without leaving a forwarding address, etc. You should set out details of your attempts to locate the registered owner.
