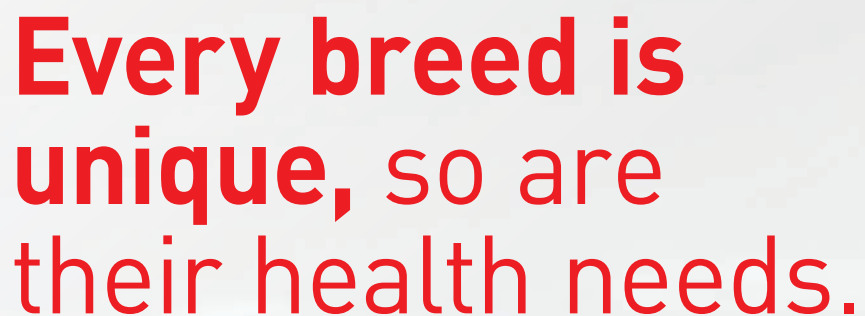

President's Message

“I'd like to thank everyone who attended our ANZAC Day Dusk Service and for the lovely feedback received from so many members.

It is important that we recognise the sacrifices that have been made by our servicemen and women and the animals that served alongside them.

Our dog world has recently lost some of our much loved members. We send our sincere condolences to their family and friends at this very sad time.

It is a timely reminder not to take life lightly. Enjoy every moment. We never know what life has in store for us.

Whilst this is a very sensitive topic, I think we need to give consideration to a few issues.

When I was working in life insurance, we were told there were three things you had to consider in planning for the future. Living too long (planning for your old age), dying too soon (planning to care for your loved ones), or something in between (having a disability or illness).

These are typically the events that we need to consider with our dogs too!

1. Ensuring you have the ability to appropriately care for your dogs as you get older;
2. Having plans in place should you not be here to care for your dogs;
3. Having somebody responsible for the care



of your dogs should you become unwell or temporarily incapacitated.

It is important to ensure our family, friends and those we have as partners, know what your wishes are in relation to our dogs. Obviously, the best way is to have a Will in place and to keep this updated. If you do have a Will, it is important to let one or more trusted people know where the Will is located. Preferably, this will provide clear instructions as to what is to happen with respect to your dogs as well as any stored semen. This will avoid confusion and ensure that your wishes are actioned. This will hopefully also avoid the dogs being placed somewhere you would not have wanted.

It is also suggested that you maintain records of your dogs including their health records and have these readily available and easily accessible. Ensure food and veterinary needs are detailed together with any issues which should be noted.

The following are scheduled for review over the next couple of years in order for the new rules and regulations to take effect from 1 January 2027.

- Rules for the Conduct of Earthdog Tests for Small Terriers and Dachshunds.
- Regulations Part 3O – Selection and Training of Earthdog Judges

Submissions are to be received in accordance with the ANKC Ltd Procedure for Reviewing Existing Rules and Documents, a copy of which is attached. Copies of the relevant rules/regulations are attached in Word format.

It is therefore requested that any proposals for changes to these rules and regulations be submitted to the Dogs Australia Administrator by no later than 28 July 2025.

The following timetable as listed below will be used:

2025

January	Request from Dogs Australia Administrator for rule/regulation change proposals to be submitted.
28 July	Submissions completed by State/Territory committees and forwarded to the Dogs Australia Administrator.
October	All submissions distributed to Member Bodies by Dogs Australia Administrator.

2026

- May National Committee meeting
- July Confirmed minutes of the May meeting completed and submitted to Dogs Australia Administrator.
- October Minutes of the May 2026 National Committee meeting receive Dogs Australia ratification at the Dogs Australia Board meeting.
- Whilst the minutes are awaiting approval a volunteer from the National Committee will finalise the amended rules/regulations in accordance with the minutes and forward a copy in Word format to the Dogs Australia Administrator.
- November Once the minutes receive Dogs Australia ratification, a copy of the new amended rules/regulations will be made available (in addition to the existing rules/regulations) on the Dogs Australia website. They will be clearly identified as effective from 1 January 2027.

- 1 January Effective date of new rules/regulations.

PETCHIP MICROCHIP SCAM

A scam is circulating in Australia where pet owners are receiving emails from "Petchip" claiming their pet's microchip registration has expired and a fee is needed to avoid being unregistered, but this is a scam; microchip registration is for life, not council registration.

Here's a breakdown of the scam and how to protect yourself:

WHAT'S HAPPENING?

- **The Scam:**

Scammers are sending emails to pet owners, posing as "Petchip Network" or a similar company, claiming that their pet's microchip registration has expired and that they need to pay a fee to renew it.

- **The False Claim:**

The emails state that if the fee isn't paid, the pet will be shown as "unregistered" on affiliated websites and databases.

- **The Reality:**

Microchip registration is a permanent record, not a yearly or monthly renewal, and you should never need to pay to register or renew your pet's microchip.

- **The Details:**

The emails often contain personal information about the pet and owner, making them seem legitimate, but this is a tactic to trick people into clicking links or providing payment information.

HOW TO PROTECT YOURSELF:

- **Don't Click Links or Respond:**

If you receive an email like this, do not click on any links or respond to the email.

- **Delete the Email:**

Simply delete the email from your inbox.

- **Check Your Pet's Microchip Details:**

If you are unsure of your pet's microchip registration status, contact the company that registered your pet's microchip or visit Pet Address.

- **Report the Scam:**

If you receive one of these emails, report it to Scamwatch, the Australian Government's National Anti-Scam Centre.

- **Stay Alert:**

Be wary of any emails or communications claiming that you need to pay a fee to renew your pet's microchip registration.

AZAWAKH

Azawakh are known for their intelligence, loyalty, and affectionate nature towards family members and those they choose to trust and accept.

The Azawakh is one of the rarest breeds of dog in the world. They are bred by the Tuareg nomads of the Sahelian zone of the southern Sahara, originating from Mali, Burkina Faso and Niger. They have been isolated from the outside world for thousands of years by the Azawakh Valley. With a fierce guarding instinct, any stranger, human or animal approaching the nomad's camp is rarely friendly. A keen intelligence, strong guarding instincts and fierce loyalty to their people necessitated by the struggle to survive in one of the harshest landscapes makes the Azawakh a very hardy breed, that to this day has natural survival instincts are very close to the surface.

The first Azawakhs formally exported were taken to France and what was then Yugoslavia in the 1970s by civil servants working in the French colonies. Whilst living in Mali, Frenchman Renato Parigi came to know a beautiful Azawakh bitch named Toboro, who was mated to a male called Hexer. Renato named a female from the litter Toboroll, and bred her twice in Mali, to local males, Aikar in 1972 and Aourakh in 1973. He brought her and some of her offspring home to France, along with a new male named Adignaz, who he bred to Toboro II in 1974. In 1978, he imported and used a fourth male, Targoui. Toboro II and Aikar produced the male Oueleda, who was brought to France and mated to a new bitch Tahoura, imported from Mali in 1975 by Francois Roussel, a veterinary student researching his PhD on the breed. This mating produced L'Azeraf, a well-known sire present in many Western pedigrees.

Toboroll x Adignaz produced the bitch Kaola, who was bred to another imported Mali male, Takadamat in 1979. This mating produced Pegga, dam of the famous sire Timgad, also present in many Western pedigrees. Kaola's littermate, J'Temse, was bred to Ouahed, imported from Mali by Guy Mazzel. So began what is referred to as the "French line".

Concurrently, Dr Pečar, a Yugoslavian ambassador in Burkina Faso and Mali, fell in love with the image of an Azawakh in an ancient mosaic. He was ecstatic to learn these dogs still existed, but found it was not Tuareg custom to sell them to strangers. He was a big game hunter, who in return for his services, managed to obtain a male, Gao, and a bitch, Lara, whom he brought home to Yugoslavia. Pečar placed his dogs in the care of Mrs Vesna Sekalec, who bred them on his behalf, under the kennel name Haris al Sahra. A second male, Darkoye Sidi, was imported from Burkina Faso in 1976, and bred to Gao and Lara's daughters. Both Gao and Darkoye Sidi were bred back to their female offspring many times to create what is known as the "Yugoslavian line".

In Germany, in 1977, Anne and Ulrich Hochges (and the first to import Azawakh into Germany) founded their Aulad al Sahra kennel by breeding Darkoye Sidi over their first bitch – Haris al Sahra's Begum, and subsequently were the first kennel to breed Azawakh from the French and Yugoslavian lines together.

At the same time, in Switzerland, Ingrid Aigeldinger began her kennel, AlHara, by initially breeding the lines separately, then combined them from the 1980s. One of her half-French/half-Yugoslavian bitches, Al Hara's Hiba, was exported to Gisela Cook-Schmidt of the Reckendahl kennel in Arizona, and whelped the first recorded litter in the USA in October 1987.

Three years later a dog from this litter, Reckendahl's Isesi, became the first Azawakh of David Moore in the USA. In 1993, David mated him to Al Hara's Tarada to produce the famous bitch known simply as Jana, whose descendants are found in a vast number of pedigrees all over the world, including Australia.

A small number of new African Azawakhs arrived in Europe in the 980s.

In France, Gervais Coppé founded the Kel Tarbanassen kennel, importing two bitches: B'Kleine Drei and B'Tekewelt... and two dogs: Ejeker and C'Babash, from Mali. B'Tekewelt, Ejeker and C'Babash form the sire-line of the famous dog Firhoun, found in most European pedigrees. B'Tekewelt was the first brindle Azawakh brought to Europe.

In Germany, Ursula and Reinhard Arnold of the 'n shat-ehad kennel imported Biyanou and Dazol in Chenan from Mali and the male Yaris from Niger. Elisabeth Eiles and Hans-Jürgen Strassner imported the male Aikar Elkor and the bitches Ackchi and Salome from Mali; and Salome

became the founding mother of Leane Krätzig's Kel Tin-Hinan kennel.

The Azawakh is a slender and elegant African sighthound with a rich history and unique characteristics. Originally bred by nomadic tribes in the Sahara for hunting and protection, this breed is known for its slender build and affectionate nature and loyalty towards family members.

ORIGIN AND HISTORY

The Azawakh descends from ancient sighthounds depicted in Central Sahara wall paintings, dating back thousands of years. The increasing aridity of the Sahara led Tuareg, Dahoussahaq, and Peul shepherd-hunters to migrate with their dogs to the more hospitable lands of the Sahel, particularly the Azawakh Valley. Known as Oska in the Tuareg language, the breed was discovered by European enthusiasts in 1968.

The breed was first introduced into Australia in 2010 with a female, Ruma (Ch. Worgeordie Endidi Na'ema Imp UK) being imported, then 2 years later Wakili (Grand. Ch. Wakili Ak Ilaman Imp Esp)

by Debra Huon of Jumadabey kennels. Then on the 15 July 2013 the first litter of puppies was born and so began the history of the Azawakh in Australia.

PHYSICAL CHARACTERISTICS

The Azawakh is particularly slim and elegant, giving a general impression of great slenderness. Its' bone structure and muscles show through thin and dry skin. The breed fits into a rectangle with a vertical long side. Males typically stand 64-74 cm tall and weigh 20-25 kg, while females are 60-70 cm tall and weigh 15-20 kg. The coat is short, fine, and tight-fitting, with colours ranging from fawn to dark fawn, white markings with or without black brindling.

TEMPERAMENT AND BEHAVIOUR

Azawakh are known for their intelligence, loyalty, and affectionate nature towards family members and those they choose to trust and accept. They can be reserved with strangers and require a lot of careful socialization and training due to their highly suspicious nature. They are definitely not suited for novice owners. The breed is quick, attentive, and

distant, but can be gentle and affectionate with their family. Additionally, they were bred to protect the encampment and livestock, making them excellent guardians. They are also used for hunting.

Azawakh are a versatile breed and with the right owner willing to put the time in socialising and exposing them to everyday things, lots of activities are possible if the Azawakh is willing to do it – Lure Coursing, Agility, Obedience, Flyball, showing and the list goes on. This breed is definitely NOT the breed for everyone – if you don't want an inside dog don't get an Azawakh! If you want a dog that doesn't bark, that happily greets visitors and strangers and lives outside the Azawakh is not for you! Azawakh are a primitive breed, their primary function is that of camp guardian first and foremost, hunter second.

HEALTH CONSIDERATIONS

The Azawakh is generally healthy and robust, but there are some health issues that may pop up. Responsible breeding practices, including health testing, are essential to mitigate risks of inheritable conditions. Some known health issues

include hypothyroidism, epilepsy, Wobblers, IVDD, and autoimmune-mediated diseases.

ADDITIONAL CHARACTERISTICS

- LifeSpan: 12 to 15 years.
- Friendliness: Varies from highly suspicious of new things and strangers to being friendly to everyone.
- Kid-Friendly: Suitable if children are calm and gentle and the Azawakh has grown up with them.

- Pet-Friendly: High.
- Exercise Needs: Medium.
- Playfulness: High.
- Energy Level: Medium to High.
- Train Ability: Medium to High.
- Intelligence: High.
- Tendency to Bark: High.
- Amount of Shedding: Low.

Main and Limited Register - Which is the right one for my dog?

On the Dogs Australia Pedigree Dog Register, there are two primary registers for purebred dogs: the **Main Register** and the **Limited Register**. Both registers confirm a dog's purebred status, but they differ in terms of breeding and competition eligibility.

A breeder may make an application to register a puppy on the Main or Limited Register at the time of litter registration.

The decision to place a dog on either the Main or Limited Register is typically made by the breeder at the time of litter registration. This choice is based on factors like the dog's conformity to Dogs Australia Regulations and its suitability for breeding or showing.

It's important to note that while both registers acknowledge a dog's purebred status, the Main Register offers broader opportunities for breeding and participation in Conformation Shows, whereas

the Limited Register is generally designated for dogs intended as pets or companions without breeding rights and can participate in dog sports.

MAIN REGISTER

The Main Register is open to dogs whelped from a Sire and Dam that are both registered either on the Main Register of Dogs Australia or other Register or Studbook recognised by Dogs Australia and the application is accompanied with a DNA Parentage verification report that qualifies the puppies to the Sire and Dam. (*Dogs Queensland Rules, Section 19.2(1)*)



MAIN REGISTER:

- **Pedigree Papers:** Dogs on the Main Register receive blue-coloured pedigree papers.
- **Breeding Eligibility:** These dogs are permitted to be bred with other Main Register dogs of the same breed, and their offspring are registered as purebred dogs. **
- **Competition Eligibility:** Main Register dogs can participate in all Dogs Australia-sanctioned events, including Conformation Shows.
- **Export Eligibility:** These dogs are eligible for export.**

**Dogs can also be registered on the Main Register with breeder conditions including not for breeding and not for export.

LIMITED REGISTER

The Limited Register is open to dogs whelped from a Sire and Dam that are both registered either in the Main Register of Dogs Australia or other Register or Studbook recognised by Dogs Australia and the application is accompanied with a DNA Parentage verification report that qualifies the puppies to the Sire and Dam. (*Dogs Queensland Rules, Section 19.2(2)*)

At the time of registration, if the dog is to be registered on the Limited Register or on the Main Register with conditions (e.g. not for breeding and/or not for export), an Official CCCQ Ltd Limited Register Agreement statement from the purchaser stating that the implications of the Limited Register or Main Register conditions are understood is to be attached to the litter application and signed by the new owner. (*Dogs Queensland Rules, Section 21.1(5)*)

LIMITED REGISTER:

- **Pedigree Papers:** Dogs on the Limited Register are issued orange-coloured pedigree papers.
- **Breeding Restrictions:** These dogs are not intended for breeding purposes. However, under certain circumstances, the original breeder may apply to upgrade a dog's status from the Limited to the Main Register.
- **Competition Eligibility:** Limited Register dogs are eligible to compete in various Dogs Australia events, such as Obedience, Agility, and other performance sports, but they are not permitted to participate in Conformation Shows.
- **Export Restrictions:** These dogs are not eligible for export.

A dog can only be placed on the Limited Register for the following reasons:

1. Conditions listed in [Dogs Queensland Rules](#) under Appendix 1 – Dogs Australia Regulations Part 6 (page 70).
2. Dog is the result of a close relative mating i.e. mother/son, father/daughter or brother/sister.
3. Health issues such as congenital, deformities or genetic (hereditary conditions).
4. Failed health test of the parents.

When you register your next litter, ensure you are only registering a dog on the Limited Register for the reasons above. Another option is to register the dog on the Main Register with conditions such as not for breeding and/or not for export which will allow the owner to participate in Conformation Shows but not breed or export the dog. It's important for the future of Dogs Queensland that new members and potential members have opportunities to own a main registered dog and to be involved in breeding and Conformation Shows to allow growth of the organisation.

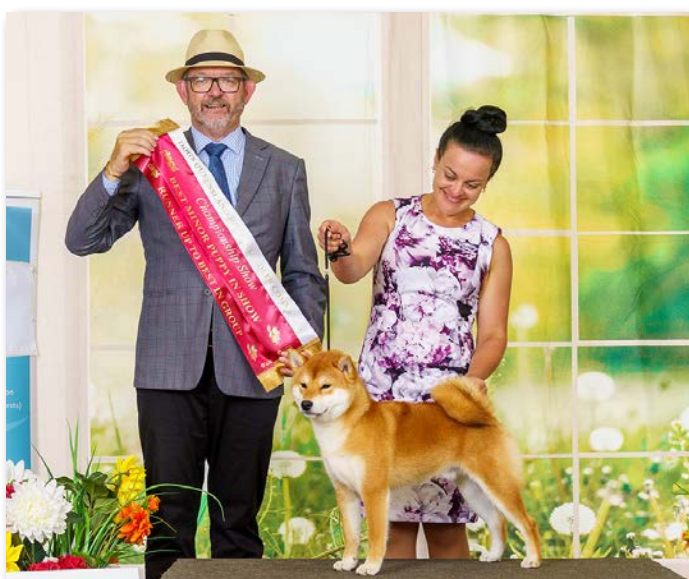

RULE 21 – OBLIGATION TO REGISTER

- 21.1 A member who breeds a litter of dogs, the parents of which are registered or eligible for registration with the CCCQ Ltd or other recognised canine controlling body must:
- (1) Register such litter, including all of the living progeny in such litter at one (1) and the same time within eighteen (18) calendar months of the date of whelping or prior to sale or rehoming (see Rule 28). No litter will be registered after twelve (12) months of age without the approval of the CCCQ Ltd;
 - (2) Comply with CCCQ Ltd Rules and correctly complete all forms required by the CCCQ Ltd;
 - (3) Pay such fees as are determined from time to time by the CCCQ Ltd. A standard fee will be set for registrations received by the office on a date within four (4) months of the date of whelping and a higher fee for registrations received by the office on a date between four (4) and six (6) months or between six (6) and twelve (12) months of the date of whelping;
 - (4) Where the breeder wishes to register a puppy with the breeder's name as part owner, an Agreement signed by the purchaser of the puppy is to be attached to the application to register the litter. Only official CCCQ Ltd Partnership Agreement forms are to be used;
 - (5) Where the breeder wishes to register a puppy on the Limited Register, an Official CCCQ Ltd Limited Register Agreement statement from the purchaser stating that the implications of the Limited Register are understood is to be attached to the application; and
 - (6) A breeder may, at time of registration on the General Register, endorse registration "Not to be exported".

Vale - Lynda Trotter

It is with great sadness that the Belgian Shepherd Dog Club of Queensland writes to honour the passing of our beloved President Lynda Trotter – a dear friend, a passionate BSD lover, a talented Judge, and a woman whose tireless work laid the foundation for something truly enduring: a Queensland community devoted to the Belgian Shepherd Dog.

Lynda's connection to the breed was deep and instinctive. She understood the heart of a Belgian Shepherd – their loyalty, intelligence, sensitivity, and drive – and she worked tirelessly to ensure they had a place where their beauty, purpose, and versatility would be recognised, protected, and celebrated.

Before the internet, before social media, Lynda along with a small group of committed Belgian enthusiasts were putting pen to paper – literally – sending handwritten letters across Queensland and interstate in the late 1980s and early 1990s, calling out to anyone who loved this remarkable breed. From that call, the Belgian Shepherd Dog Club of Queensland (BSDCQ) was born in 1990.

Lynda stepped into the Presidents role in 1991 and again in 1992 – at a time when the Club's very survival was in question. Meetings had dwindled. Morale was low. And yet, it was under Lynda's leadership that the Club found its feet again.

Lynda was not loud, was not boastful – but she was steady. Grounded. Determined. She helped instill the values that still define the Club today: ethical breeding, health testing, rescue, education,



celebration of all four Belgian varieties – Malinois, Tervueren, Groenendael, and Laekenois – and most importantly, a sense of community.

Along with other Committee and Club Members, Lynda was pivotal in so many initiatives:

- Introduced health testing requirements for advertising,
- Established the first hip score register and then genetic register,
- Launched a Rescue Service and established relationships with shelters,
- Ran fun days that brought joy and connection – from obedience displays to Belgian Olympics,
- Printed newsletters and yearbooks, created club banners, held breed lectures and BBQs,

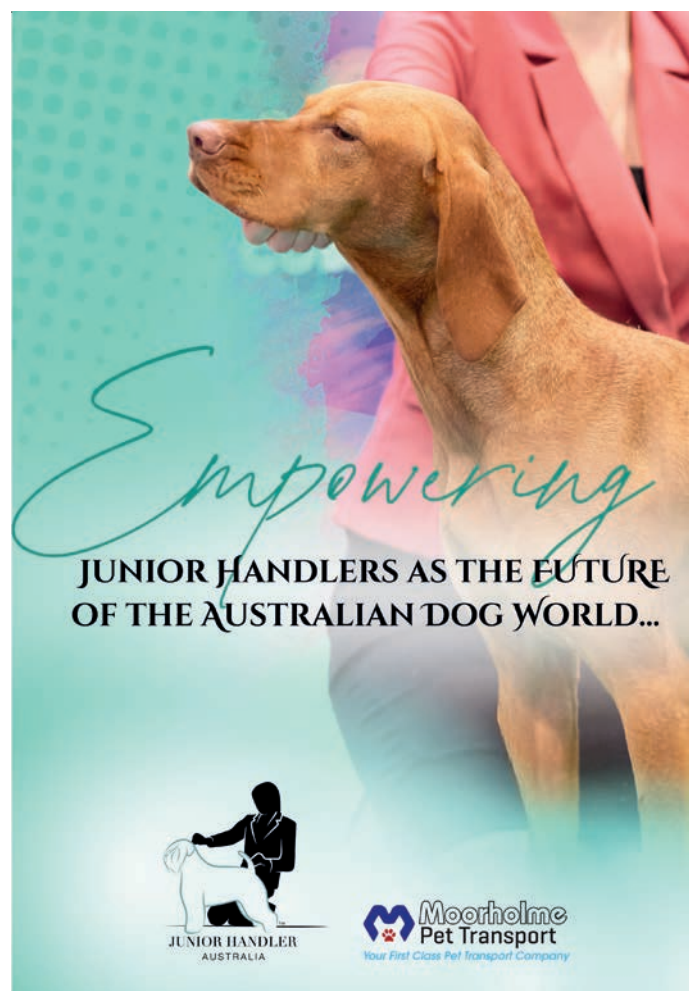
and encouraged owners to come together not only in competition, but in celebration.

Lynda was there through the long hours and quiet (and loud!) meetings, always ready to carry the vision when others stepped back. And because of that, the BSDCQ is not just a club—it is a significant part of Lynda's legacy. One that has grown, matured, and continues to support generations of dogs and their people.

For those of us privileged to know her, Lynda was more than a founder – she was a loving and steady friend, a thoughtful mentor, a generous soul. She made room for others. She uplifted the breed without ego. She gave herself to something larger than any one dog or one win – she gave herself to building a lasting home for the breed she loved.

We see her now walking under that vast, starry night sky, with Malinois, Tervueren, Laekenois, and Groenendael padding softly at her side. And in that quiet, we say thank you, Lynda. For all you did. For all you gave. You will forever be part of the heartbeat of the Belgian Shepherd Dog Club of Queensland.

Rest well. We will continue to carry your vision forward.

THE SPORT OF SCENT WORK

The sport of Scent Work is based on the principles of professional detection dog tasks. Dogs are trained to locate a specific odour and effectively communicate to their handler that the target odour has been located. Scent work is an ideal exercise for all breeds and is highly conducive to dogs with various challenges including the older dogs, deaf dogs, dogs with disabilities, environmental sensitivities, and any size from toy to giant breeds. It is also a great sport for reactive dogs or those requiring space as only one dog competes at a time and dogs can enjoy using their sense of smell and natural hunting instinct to search out the target odour in a safe space, while being supported by their handler and having fun!

Your dog's sense of smell is their most powerful and important sense. By introducing your puppy, adult, or senior dog to the sport of Scent Work they will enjoy a meaningful activity along with physical and mental stimulation. Scent Work is fun and interactive for both you and your dog, and it will strengthen the bond that you already have with each other.

MEET LEXIE!

At 12 years of age, you would be forgiven for thinking German Shepherd Dog "Lexie" (Winola Little Boots) would be spending her days napping on the sofa, but this is far from the case! For over eight years, Lexie and her owner Donna Williams have actively pursued their deep love of scent-based sports.

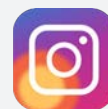

Dogs Queensland Registration Numbers are obtained from legitimate websites such as Dogs Queensland or DogzOnline, where they are displayed as required by the Queensland Government.

Please see the [Queensland Dog Breeder Fact Sheets](#) for regulations and guidelines for Queensland Dog Breeders.

An example of a typical scam is:

- A Dogs Queensland Membership number is lifted from current advertising on the internet.
- The scammer researches and obtains personal details of the breeder including name, suburb, prefix.
- A domain name similar to the Kennel prefix is registered on an offshore registry.
- Once the breeder has ceased advertising the litter of puppies a new website is published.
- No physical address or phone numbers are advertised on the website.
- The seller avoids permitting you to physically see the cyber puppy and only sends non genuine pictures.
- The seller insists on only accepting payment by a crypto currency or a funds transfer.

As a breeder what can you do to avoid being an unknowing victim of a Puppy Scam:

- Regularly Google search the internet for websites using a similar Domain Name as your Prefix.
- Put a warning notification in your online advertising to alert buyers to check any website they are looking at is legitimate.
- Encourage puppy buyers to verify breeder information with Dogs Queensland and make direct in-person contact with you.
- Ensure puppy buyers check communications are made with verified contact details.
- Encourage puppy buyers to meet the puppy and breeder before handing over payments.

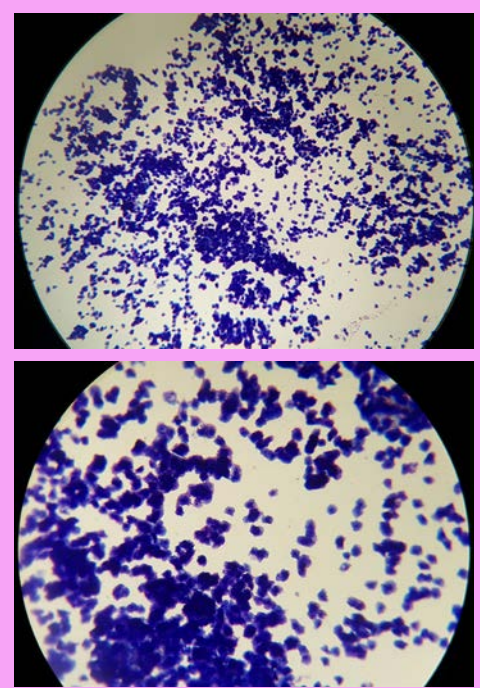

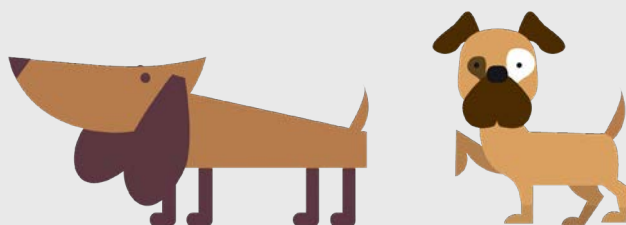

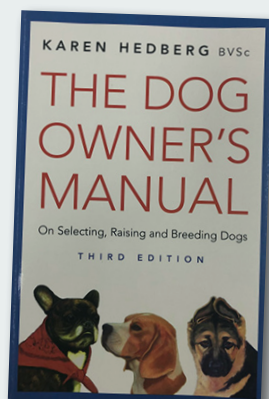

Breeder Alert – Puppy Scam Websites

Dogs Queensland has become increasingly aware of Puppy Scam Websites using legitimate Dogs Queensland Registration and Queensland Breeder Identification (BIN) Numbers to sell puppies. Dogs Queensland Registration Numbers are obtained from legitimate websites such as Dogs Queensland or DogzOnline, where they are displayed as required by the Queensland Government.

An example of a typical scam is:

- A Dogs Queensland Membership number is lifted from current advertising on the internet.
- The scammer researches and obtains personal details of the breeder including name, suburb, prefix.
- A domain name similar to the Kennel prefix is registered on an offshore registry.
- Once the breeder has ceased advertising the litter of puppies a new website is published.
- No physical address or phone numbers are advertised on the website.
- The seller avoids permitting you to physically see the cyber puppy and only sends non genuine pictures.
- The seller insists on only accepting payment by a crypto currency or a funds transfer.

As a breeder what can you do to avoid being an unknowing victim of a Puppy Scam:

- Regularly Google search the internet for websites using a similar Domain Name as your Prefix.
- Put a warning notification in your online advertising to alert buyers to check any website they are looking at is legitimate.
- Encourage puppy buyers to verify breeder information with Dogs Queensland and make direct in-person contact with you.
- Ensure puppy buyers check communications are made with verified contact details.
- Encourage puppy buyers to meet the puppy and breeder before handing over payments.

As a buyer what can you do to avoid being a victim of a Puppy Scam:

- Verify breeder information with Dogs Queensland.
- Ensure communications are made to verified contact details.
- Meet the puppy and breeder before handing over payments.
- If paying online, use a credit card or PayPal where you have a degree of buyer protection.
- Check website is an established site with a website security certificate.
- Avoid websites without physical address or phone numbers.
- Ask for proof, including ANKC registration papers and veterinary health records for any puppy.

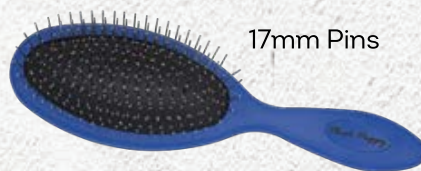
