# Dogs Australia Procedure for Upgrade of a Reserve CACIB to a CACIB

#### Introduction

1. Where the registered owner/s of a dog believe their dog which was awarded a Reserve CACIB at a FCI Show but, may be eligible to have the R-CACIB upgraded for the reasons below, may make application to the FCI through their Member Body for the R-CACIB to be upgraded to a CACIB.

#### Particular specifications regarding turning a R-CACIB into a CACIB

- 2. A R-CACIB is <u>automatically</u> turned into a CACIB if the CACIB was awarded to a dog that already has the title of C.I.B. (this title must have been confirmed by the FCI latest on the day of the show).
- 3. A R-CACIB can also be turned into a CACIB but <u>only at the request of the owner of the dog that won the R-CACIB</u> or <u>at the request of his/her national canine organisation</u> provided that one of the following requirements is met:
  - a. The CACIB was awarded to a dog that does not have a pedigree recognised by the FCI or has a pedigree that is recognised by the FCI but incomplete (i.e. without a minimum of 3 complete generations (14 dogs) registered with FCI recognised studbooks/appendices to the studbooks).
  - b. The CACIB was awarded to a dog that was entered in a wrong class which prevents it from being eligible for this award (see Dogs Australia Regulations Part 5 Show Classes).
  - c. The CACIB was awarded to a dog that fulfils, on the day of the show, the requirements (in terms of number of CACIB earned and necessary time required) for the title of C.I.B. This means for breeds not subject to a working test, See Dogs Australia Regulations Part 5 Show
  - d. The CACIB awarded was cancelled for any other reason.
- 4. In case the dog that has earned the R-CACIB is already a C.I.B or C.I.E, the R-CACIB can under no circumstances be turned into a CACIB.



#### **Procedure**

- 5. The procedure for making application for the R-CACIB to be upgraded to the CACIB shall be as follows:
  - a. The owner/s are to complete the attached form as shown at Appendix A, along with the prescribed fee as determined by Dogs Australia and the Member Body.

[PLEASE NOTE: FCI will not accept handwritten applications. Please complete in TYPED CAPITAL LETTERS.]

- b. The Member Body is to verify the information and once confirmed forward to Dogs Australia, for application to be made to the FCI.
- c. If approved by the FCI and the Member Body notified via Dogs Australia or verified proof from the owner/s, the Member Body is to issue a new CACIB identifying the upgrade.



# IRISH WATER SPANIEL



The Irish Water Spaniel combines utilitarian function and striking appearance, making it a remarkable breed in both recreational and competitive settings.

#### **HISTORY OF THE BREED**

The Irish Water Spaniel (IWS) is one of the oldest spaniel breeds, with roots tracing back to the 17th century in Ireland. Known for their prowess as hunting companions, especially in waterfowl retrieval, the breed played a significant role in the development of other spaniels.

The Irish Water Spaniel is believed to be influenced by various breeds, including the Portuguese Water Dog and the now-extinct Tweed Water Spaniel. The breed was officially recognized by the American Kennel Club (AKC) in 1884. Notably, they have a reputation for being less common compared to other spaniel breeds, but they have maintained a devoted following among enthusiasts who appreciate their unique characteristics.

#### **TEMPERAMENT**

The Irish Water Spaniel is known for its lively, intelligent, and independent nature, but can be aloof to strangers. They are often characterised as:

- *Energetic:* IWS requires regular exercise and mental stimulation due to their high energy levels.
- *Intelligent*: They possess a keen intelligence and are quick learners but can sometimes display a stubborn streak.
- Affectionate: They can be loyal and affectionate companions, forming strong bonds with their families.
- *Playful:* Known for their playful demeanor, they enjoy engaging in games and activities, especially those involving water.

#### **SUITABILITY FOR FAMILIES**

- Good with Children: The IWS generally interacts well with children and can be a playful and protective companion in a family setting.
- Active Lifestyle: They are best suited for active families who can provide them with the exercise and stimulation they crave. Regular walks, playtime, and swimming are ideal activities.
- *Training:* Early socialization and obedience training are essential to help curb their

independent nature. They respond well to positive reinforcement techniques.

The Irish Water Spaniel (IWS) is indeed a breed characterized by its unique physical attributes and specialized construction designed for swimming and retrieval. Below is a refined description that incorporates details, emphasizing the features relevant to breed judging and general appearance.

# GENERAL APPEARANCE OF THE IRISH WATER SPANIEL

When judging the Irish Water Spaniel, the overall impression should be that of a "keg on legs". This distinctive body shape is crucial as it not only aids in buoyancy and efficiency while swimming but also provides ample room for lung capacity, which is essential for this active breed.

#### **KEY CHARACTERISTICS**

• Body Structure: The barrel-shaped body is a hallmark of the breed, allowing for a rolling gait reminiscent of a "drunken sailor" when in motion. This unique movement stems from the breed's standard design, where the combination of loose skin and dense hair contributes to a fluid, rolling effect as the dog moves. When the dog moves at a faster pace he should be seen as having a great reach and drive with the overall power coming from the rear movement.











• *Coat:* The coat is liver or puce in colour, characterized by dense, tight curls throughout the body.

On the head, the hair forms soft ringlets that fall towards the nose in a distinct V shape.

This ringlets also extends to the legs and ears, enhancing the breed's unique aesthetic.

Notably, the area beneath the neck features a V-shaped pattern of smooth hair, contrasting with the curly coat.

 Facial Features: The Irish Water Spaniel has a soft expression, accentuated by pleasing almondshaped eyes that range from mid to dark brown, contributing to their gentle demeanour.

Facial features include sideburns and a beard, adding to the breed's distinctive profile.

• *Tail:* The breed possesses a unique "rat tail," which features one-third tight curls at the base, transitioning to shorter, straight hair towards the

tip. This tail structure further enhances the dog's swimming capabilities.

When judging the Irish Water Spaniel, I always say approach the breed confidently, don't speak over the top of them and I always suggest checking the teeth at the end of the examination.

The Irish Water Spaniel combines utilitarian function and striking appearance, making it a remarkable breed in both recreational and competitive settings. Their distinctive coat patterns, combined with their barrel-shaped body and engaging expression, highlight the importance of proper conformation in maintaining the breed's historical roles as a water retriever and versatile hunting companion.

In summary, the Irish Water Spaniel's appearance embodies both beauty and practicality, reflecting its evolution as an efficient gundog dog. When judging the breed, an appreciation for these attributes is crucial in supporting the preservation of its breed type.

# Whelping Boxes

Whelping boxes – also known as nesting boxes or birthing boxes – are essential for providing a safe, controlled environment where a pregnant dog (bitch) can give birth and care for her puppies. Here's a complete guide to understanding and choosing the right whelping box:

#### WHAT IS A WHELPING BOX?

A whelping box is an enclosed area designed to:

- Give the dam (mother dog) a safe, quiet, and clean space to give birth.
- Contain the puppies safely during their first weeks of life.
- Prevent accidental crushing of puppies by the dam using rails or bumpers (also called pig rails).
- Keep the area warm and sanitary.

#### **IDEAL FEATURES OF A WHELPING BOX**

#### Appropriate Size

Big enough for the dam to stretch out comfortably.

• Small enough to prevent puppies from straying far from her warmth.

#### 2. Pig Rails

 Bars around the inside edges to stop the mother from accidentally squashing her pups against the sides.

#### 3. Low Entry Door

• Easy for the mother to enter and exit, while still containing the puppies.

#### 4. Non-Slip Flooring

 Ensures puppies can grip the floor, reducing risk of injury (like swimmer puppy syndrome).

#### 5. Easy to Clean

 Materials like plastic or sealed wood are good; some use removable liners or absorbent pads.

#### 6. Temperature Control

 Heat lamps or heating pads may be added for warmth, especially in cooler climates.



#### **TYPES OF WHELPING BOXES**

TYPE	DESCRIPTION	PROS	CONS
Plastic Cardboard	Durable, easy to clean (e.g., Dura-Whelp boxes)	Lightweight, waterproof	Can be pricey
Wooden (DIY)	Custom-built at home	Fully customizable	Heavier, needs sealing to resist moisture
Puppy Playpens with Liners	Adaptable spaces with soft or plastic lining	Multipurpose	May lack pig rails
Disposable Cardboard	Single-use, budget-friendly	Cheap and easy	Not durable, absorbs moisture

#### **CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE**

- Change bedding daily (puppy pads, vet fleece, or clean towels).
- Disinfect the box every few days with pet-safe cleaner.
- Check temperature: keep it around 29–32°C (85–90°F) during the first few days.



#### **TIPS FOR USE**

- Introduce the dam to the box at least a week or two before her due date.
- Place it in a quiet, low-traffic room.
- Use soft bedding but avoid loose threads or materials puppies can get tangled in.

#### WHELPING DAY PREPARATION CHECKLIST

Here's a comprehensive checklist for preparing for whelping day to help you stay organized and support your dog through a safe and stress-free birthing process:

#### **WHELPING AREA SETUP**

- ✓ Whelping box (clean, dry, and ready in a quiet space)
- ✓ Pig rails to prevent squashing puppies
- ✓ Non-slip, washable bedding (e.g., vet fleece whelping pads, or towels)
- ✓ Heat source (heating pad under half the box or a safe heat lamp)
- ✓ Thermometer (keep area at 29–32°C for newborns)
- ✓ Puppy scale (to weigh puppies daily and monitor growth)

✓ Clock or notebook (to record times of birth and notes)

#### **SUPPLIES FOR THE BIRTH**

- ☑ Clean towels (to dry and rub pups)
- ✓ Unwaxed dental floss or sterile hemostats (to tie umbilical cords if needed)
- ☑ Blunt scissors (sterilized, to cut cords if necessary)
- ☑ Bulb syringe (to clear pups' airways if congested)
- ✓ Lubricant e.g., KY Jelly (for assisting stuck puppies)
- ☑ Gloves (disposable and clean)
- ☑ Rubbish bag (for soiled towels and placenta disposal)



#### **POSTPARTUM AND PUPPY CARE SUPPLIES**

☑ Milk replacer (like Wombaroo, Di-Vetelact or Royal Canin BABYDOG Milk, in case the dam can't nurse)



- ✓ Feeding bottles or syringes (for handfeeding)
- ✓ Thermometer (to monitor the dam's temperature over 39.5°C may indicate infection)
- ☑ Digital scale (accurate to the gram)
- ✓ Puppy ID bands or nail polish (to track each puppy)

#### **CARE FOR THE DAM**

- ✓ Fresh water and food nearby (high-calorie, easily digestible)
- ☑ Calcium supplement (check with your vet)
- ☑ Exercise area (for short bathroom breaks)
- ✓ Vet contact number easily accessible
- ✓ Emergency vet 24/7 info (in case of complications)

#### **KNOW WHEN TO CALL THE VET**

- ☑ No pup after 2 hours of strong contractions
- ✓ More than 2 hours between pups with contractions
- ☑ Green/black discharge with no pup delivered
- ☑ Excessive bleeding or signs of distress
- ✓ Dam refuses to care for pups or shows signs of illness

#### **OPTIONAL EXTRAS**

- ☑ Puppy journal or digital app to track weight, feeding, development
- ✓ Infrared camera or baby monitor (to observe without disturbing)
- ☑ Cleaning supplies (disinfectant, extra pads, gloves)

# THROUGH THE LENS: Where Canine Passion Meets Photography

There's a special magic that happens when two passions intersect. For me, that moment came in the early 2000s when I acquired my first pedigree Staffordshire Bull Terrier, creating the perfect subject for a love of photography that began in my teenage years.

I still remember the weight of my father's Pentax 35mm in my hands – a trust that I wouldn't drop his prized possession and my gateway to capturing life's fleeting moments. Those early experiences taught me something crucial: the best photographs don't just document; they reveal what others miss.

The dog show circuit presents unique photographic challenges. From the API show weekends to Western Classics and Dog of the Year events, I've documented the passion of the dog community. What began as photographing my own Staffies expanded to helping friends, then to official photography for Breed Specialties, and eventually to All-Breed Shows, and now to running a Portrait Studio while earning several awards along the way.

Whether in studio settings or natural environments, the fundamental challenge remains: honouring the subject's true essence within the frame.

As dog enthusiasts, we understand that our time with these remarkable animals is limited. Photographs freeze moments that would otherwise exist only in memory. They immortalize that perfect stance, that joyful expression, that defining characteristic that made each dog uniquely special.

In a world dominated by smartphone snapshots, there remains profound value in approaching photography with intention. The difference between a casual photo and a thoughtful portrait isn't just technical quality—it's the ability to reveal character and tell a story without words.

The ribbons may fade and trophies gather dust, but a powerful image of your dog in their prime will always bring you back to the joy and beauty of your journey together. After all, dogs give us so much in their brief time with us. Preserving those memories through thoughtful photography isn't just documentation—it's an act of gratitude.

# DOGS QUEENSLAND PAWS AID & ANZAC DAY SPIRIT CHAMPIONSHIP SHOWS



#### RULE 21 – OBLIGATION TO REGISTER

- 21.1 A member who breeds a litter of dogs, the parents of which are registered or eligible for registration with the CCCQ Ltd or other recognised canine controlling body must:
  - (1) Register such litter, including all of the living progeny in such litter at one (1) and the same time within eighteen (18) calendar months of the date of whelping or prior to sale or rehoming (see Rule 28). No litter will be registered after twelve (12) months of age without the approval of the CCCQ Ltd;
  - (2) Comply with CCCQ Ltd Rules and correctly complete all forms required by the CCCQ Ltd;
  - (3) Pay such fees as are determined from time to time by the CCCQ Ltd. A standard fee will be set for registrations received by the office on a date within four (4) months of the date of whelping and a higher fee for registrations received by the office on a date between four (4) and six (6) months or between six (6) and twelve (12) months of the date of whelping;
  - (4) Where the breeder wishes to register a puppy with the breeder's name as part owner, an Agreement signed by the purchaser of the puppy is to be attached to the application to register the litter. Only official CCCQ Ltd Partnership Agreement forms are to be used;
  - (5) Where the breeder wishes to register a puppy on the Limited Register, an Official CCCQ Ltd Limited Register Agreement statement from the purchaser stating that the implications of the Limited Register are understood is to be attached to the application; and
  - (6) A breeder may, at time of registration on the General Register, endorse registration "Not to be exported".

## Breeder Alert – Puppy Scam Websites

Dogs Queensland has become increasingly aware of Puppy Scam Websites using legitimate Dogs Queensland Registration and Queensland Breeder Identification (BIN) Numbers to sell puppies. Dogs Queensland Registration Numbers are obtained from legitimate websites such as Dogs Queensland or DogzOnline, where they are displayed as required by the Queensland Government.

Please see the <u>Queensland Dog Breeder Fact Sheets</u> for regulations and guidelines for Queensland Dog Breeders.

#### An example of a typical scam is:

- A Dogs Queensland Membership number is lifted from current advertising on the internet.
- The scammer researches and obtains personal details of the breeder including name, suburb, prefix.
- A domain name similar to the Kennel prefix is registered on an offshore registry.
- Once the breeder has ceased advertising the litter of puppies a new website is published.
- No physical address or phone numbers are advertised on the website.
- The seller avoids permitting you to physically see the cyber puppy and only sends non genuine pictures.
- The seller insists on only accepting payment by a crypto currency or a funds transfer.

# As a breeder what can you do to avoid being an unknowing victim of a Puppy Scam:

- Regularly Google search the internet for websites using a similar Domain Name as your Prefix.
- Put a warning notification in your online advertising to alert buyers to check any website they are looking at is legitimate.
- Encourage puppy buyers to verify breeder information with Dogs Queensland and make direct in-person contact with you.
- Ensure puppy buyers check communications are made with verified contact details.
- Encourage puppy buyers to meet the puppy and breeder before handing over payments.

# My Hero


# 'The bond between a human and their dog is unlike no other.'

Eileen Mavis Jones, born on 31 January 1930, and passing on 17 April 2025, was a dedicated figure in the dog show community and married to Vic Jones – a Life Member and Honorary Councillor of Dogs Queensland. Eileen's journey in the world of dog showing began when she requested a Cocker Spaniel as a gift during her pregnancy with their daughter, Margaret.

For 72 years, she supported Vic by caring for their dogs, nurturing litters, and assisting him in his roles as President and Vice President of various clubs, including the Gundog and Heavy Breeds Club, which he revitalized in the 1960s.

Eileen was known for her hospitality, often entertaining judges at home and working tirelessly in the canteen. As Margaret grew up and participated in dog shows, Eileen was always by her side, providing unwavering support.

A passionate lover of American Cocker Spaniels, Eileen had a special bond with a notable dog named Dolly – the first of her breed born in Australia. Vic later bought another from the same kennel but as Eileen spoilt this girl, she would only show for her.

At a Brisbane Royal one year, Joe Braddon, a well known judge from the UK, refused 1st place and handed Eileen a 2nd place ribbon. Eileen gave it back to the judge and walked out of the ring.

The President of the CCC Henry Phillips, was so angry he took it to the ANKC annual meeting to have a rule that no judge can refuse a first place.

This rule still stands today, so we can thank Eileen for it.

Throughout her life, she travelled the world with Vic on his judging assignments, meeting many esteemed breeders and judges.


Eileen leaves behind a loving family, including her husband, daughter, six grandchildren, sixteen great-grandchildren, and one greatgreat-granddaughter.


Her contributions to the Queensland dog community and her warm presence will be deeply missed by all who knew her.

# **Breeder Alert – Puppy Scam Websites**

Dogs Queensland has become increasingly aware of Puppy Scam Websites using legitimate Dogs Queensland Registration and Queensland Breeder Identification (BIN) Numbers to sell puppies. Dogs Queensland Registration Numbers are obtained from legitimate websites such as Dogs Queensland or DogzOnline, where they are displayed as required by the Queensland Government.



Please see the <u>Queensland Dog Breeder Fact Sheets</u> for regulations and guidelines for Queensland Dog Breeders.

#### An example of a typical scam is:

- A Dogs Queensland Membership number is lifted from current advertising on the internet.
- The scammer researches and obtains personal details of the breeder including name, suburb, prefix.
- A domain name similar to the Kennel prefix is registered on an offshore registry.
- Once the breeder has ceased advertising the litter of puppies a new website is published.
- No physical address or phone numbers are advertised on the website.
- The seller avoids permitting you to physically see the cyber puppy and only sends non genuine pictures.
- The seller insists on only accepting payment by a crypto currency or a funds transfer.

#### As a breeder what can you do to avoid being an unknowing victim of a Puppy Scam:

- Regularly Google search the internet for websites using a similar Domain Name as your Prefix.
- Put a warning notification in your online advertising to alert buyers to check any website they are looking at is legitimate.
- Encourage puppy buyers to verify breeder information with Dogs Queensland and make direct inperson contact with you.
- Ensure puppy buyers check communications are made with verified contact details.
- Encourage puppy buyers to meet the puppy and breeder before handing over payments.

#### As a buyer what can you do to avoid being a victim of a Puppy Scam:

- Verify breeder information with Dogs Queensland.
- Ensure communications are made to verified contact details.
- Meet the puppy and breeder before handing over payments.
- If paying online, use a credit card or PayPal where you have a degree of buyer protection.
- Check website is an established site with a website security certificate.
- Avoid websites without physical address or phone numbers.
- Ask for proof, including ANKC registration papers and veterinary health records for any puppy.
