UPDATE TO REGULATIONS RE: BULLMASTIFF SURVEY RESULTS

Following a survey last year relating to the age of stud dogs' requirements for registration of Bullmastiff puppies on the Main or limited register, it was unanimously resolved at the February 2026 Special Board meeting that the survey results be endorsed. As a result of the decision, Regulations Part 6 – The Register & Registration Clause 8.14 will be amended as follows:

8.14.4 A Bullmastiff male may NOT be used at stud before the age of 12 months is reached. Puppies born where the stud dog was not 12 months of age at the date of mating shall be registered on the Limited Register only and flagged "NOT TO BE UPGRADED"

8.14.5 Semen can be collected over 9 months of age but cannot be used until the dog is over 12 months of age and had the relevant health testing requirements for that breed. Puppies born where the stud dog was not 12 months of age at the date of mating shall be registered on the Limited Register only and flagged "NOT TO BE UPGRADED"

INTENTION TO LODGE A COMPLAINT

All Members are reminded of the following Rule in regards to Shows.

71.9 Incidents involving members which occur at Exhibitions or Club activities of any kind are to be reported to the Event Manager or Club official (President or Secretary) immediately. All details of the incident are to be noted and forwarded in a report submitted to the Secretary of the CCCQ Ltd with the Event Manager's Report within five (5) working days.

In cases where the member / non member wishes to lodge a formal complaint, a Notice of Intention to Lodge a Complaint form must be completed on the day of the Exhibition and forwarded with the Event Manager's Report. The member then has fourteen (14) days from the date of the Exhibition to lodge the complaint in accord with the Dogs Queensland Complaints Procedure. Failure to lodge a complaint within that period will cause the complaint to lapse (see Appendix 5 – page 91 [RULE BOOK](#)).

SUMMARY OF THE DOGS AUSTRALIA SPECIAL BOARD MEETING HELD IN MELBOURNE ON 21 FEBRUARY 2026

At the February 2026 Dogs Australia Special Board meeting, Directors resolved/considered the following:

1. * Regulations Part 5 – Conformation Show: Amendment

It was RESOLVED that the following amendment to Regulations Part 5 – Conformation Show be endorsed:

Definitions

Insert new

- 1.1.9 Fast & Furious – A Championship Show which is conducted in accordance with Section 7 and 8 of the regulations with capped numbers. The maximum number of Fast and Furious Events/Weekends/Shows to be conducted by each member body shall be ** per calendar year

Currently reads:

- 1.2.3 Mandatory Classes - at all Conformation Shows (Excluding CACIB), Baby Puppy, Puppy and Open.

Amend to read:

- 1.2.3 Mandatory Classes - at all Conformation Shows (Excluding CACIB), Puppy and Open.

Currently reads:

- 7.1.7 General Specials - [NOTE: Where an affiliate is conducting more than one show on the same day and General Specials are not to be offered, it may only be at on the last show on that day.

Amend to read:

- 7.1.7 General Specials - [NOTE: Where an affiliate is conducting more than one show on the same day and General Specials are not to be offered, it may only be at on the last show on that day. (Excluding Fast and Furious events)].

Currently reads:

- 8.3.7 General Specials - is to be offered at all Alternative in-Group and in-Show Placing System Championship Shows.

Amend to read:

- 8.3.7 General Specials - is to be offered at all Alternative in-Group and in-Show Placing System Championship Shows (Excluding Fast an Furious events)].

These amendments will be effective from 1 January 2027.

2. Bullmastiff Survey - Endorsement

It was RESOLVED that the Bullmastiff survey results be endorsed and for the following limitation to be added to the current Bullmastiff Litter Registration Limitations and to apply for all litters born after 1 July 2026.

1. A Bullmastiff male may NOT be used at stud before the age of 12 months is reached. Litters which do not meet the above requirements will not be registered.
2. Semen can be collected over 9 months of age but cannot be used until the dog is over 12 months of age and had the relevant health testing requirements for that breed.

* Regulations Part 6 – The Register & Registration Clause 8.14 will be updated accordingly.

3. Junior Class

It was RESOLVED that effective from 1 January 2027 Dogs Australia allow for Junior Class to be awarded at in group and in show level at Group 1-4 Shows.

4. * Regulations Part 6 – The Register & Registration: Amendment

It was RESOLVED that Regulations Part 6 – The Register & Registration, Clause 6.9 Registration of Associate Dogs be amended as follows:

Current reads:

6.9 Registration of Associate Dogs – on Associate Register (10/07, 7.11) (Amended 10/10, 5.11) (Amended 10/19, 6.1)

6.9.1 As from 1 January 2008, it is compulsory PRIOR to the registration of an Associate Dog on the National Database, that the application to register such dog is accompanied by a Sterilisation Certificate or a recognised Animal Register official documentation showing the owner, microchip number and indicating that the dog is desexed.

6.9.2 The dog to be permanently identified (such as Microchip) and the permanent identified number to be recorded on the Sterilisation Certificate.

6.9.3 The breed is to be recorded as 'Associate' with a number assigned by the Dogs Australia Member Body and only the following details are to be recorded on the National Database:

- a. name (one word only).
- d. sex - indicated only as either neutered or spayed.
- e. microchip number.
- f. date of birth (if known).
- g. colour

Note: The breed or cross breed may be recorded in the notes field for further reference.

6.9.4 The Dogs Australia Member Body will produce an Associate Register Certificate for an Associate dog, which indicates the above details.

Amend to read:

6.9 Registration of Associate Dogs – on Associate Register (10/07, 7.11) (Amended 10/10, 5.11) (Amended 10/19, 6.1)

6.9.1 Effective from 1 January 2027 it is compulsory PRIOR to the registration of an Associate Dog on the National Database, that the application to register such dog is accompanied by a Sterilisation Certificate or a recognised Animal Register official document confirming the dog is neutered, or where the dog is being registered through an Dogs Australia recognised Kindred body, a letter of authenticity, issued by the recognised body detailing the dog's reproductive status.

6.9.2 Any person registering an entire dog on the Associate Register must be a full member of the member body in which they reside.

6.9.3 The dog to be permanently identified by Microchip and the permanent identified number to be recorded on the documentation as provided at 6.9.1.

6.9.4 The Breed is to be recorded as 'Associate' with a (AR) number assigned by the Dogs Australia Member Body and only the following details are to be recorded on the National Database:

- a. Name (to conform to Dogs Australia regulations). Where there is an Dogs Australia registered prefix it is to be included as part of the name.
- b. sex - indicated only as either Dog, Bitch or Neutered.

- c. microchip number.
- d. date of birth (or approximate).
- e. colour.
- f. Breeder (if known).
- g. Current owners name and address.

Note: The suspected breed or cross breed may be recorded in the notes field for further reference.

- 6.9.5 The Dogs Australia Member Body will produce an Associate Register Certificate for an Associate dog, which indicates the above details.
- 6.9.6 A litter born to both the Sire and Dam on the Associate Register may be registered on the Associate register where the owner has a registered prefix with the Dogs Australia and is a current financial member of a Dogs Australia Member body.
- 6.9.7 To be recognised as a Kindred Body the entity must make application to Dogs Australia for recognition. The application must stipulate the activities conducted by the entity, time in existence, number of members and dogs registered to them and why they are making application to be associated with Dogs Australia. The Dogs Australia Board of Directors is to assess the application at the next available board meeting and notify the entity as soon as possible after the meeting.

5. * Regulations Part 8 – Member Bodies & Membership, Clause 4.5: Amendment

It was RESOLVED that effective after ratification of the minutes of the February 2026 Special Board meeting, Dogs Australia Regulations Part 8: Member Bodies & Membership, Clause 4.5, which reads as follows:-

- 4.5 Any suspension of membership placed on any member of a Member Body shall be upheld by all other Member Bodies.

Amend to read:

- 4.5 Any suspension and/or termination of membership placed on any member of a Member Body shall be upheld by all other Member Bodies.

6. Rename Bale Hunt to Bale Seek

It was RESOLVED that Dogs Australia rename the adopted discipline Bale Hunt to Bale Seek.

7. Australian Representative at the World Dog Show

It was RESOLVED that the dog or bitch that is selected to represent Australia at the world dog show be an animal that is bred in Australia. This requirement will start with the dog selected as Australia's representative for the 2027 world dog show.

Rules 2026

RULES FOR THE CONDUCT OF QUEENSLAND DOG OF THE YEAR COMPETITION IN 2026

GENERAL RULES

1. The Queensland Dog of the Year Competition will be sponsored, promoted and run by Dogs Queensland, commencing on Thursday, 1st January 2026 and ending on Thursday, 31st December 2026.
2. The Dog of the Year Final will be judged on Saturday evening, 6th February 2027.
3. In the event that a cash prize is awarded for the Competition, the prize will be awarded in the name of the Queensland resident owner/s of the winning exhibit. Where an exhibit is held in joint ownership with a current financial member of the ANKC, that member must be financial as of 1st January 2026 up to and including 6th February 2027.
4. Finalists in the competition will receive a memento from the Events Committee.
5. Catalogues for the Competition will be available for a fee.
6. The Committee is authorised to take steps to verify the eligibility of Competition finalists. Should an exhibitor or exhibit not meet all the specific criteria for eligibility, the exhibit in question will not be permitted to compete in the Competition Final.
7. The Events Committee reserves the right to alter any Competition rules should it be deemed necessary.
8. The Dogs Queensland Board of Directors is the final arbiter of disputed issues in respect to this Competition and exhibitors acknowledge that, by entering this Competition, they agree to be bound by the Rules and they further agree to indemnify Dogs Queensland against all claims arising from any actions associated with this Competition.

ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE

In order to qualify for Dog of the Year, the exhibit must reside in the State of Queensland from 1st January 2026 or born during 2026 and reside in the State of Queensland and must remain resident in the State until the Competition date, 6th February 2027.

The exhibit must be registered to a Dogs Queensland member either solely or in partnership during this period (General Rules 3).

To reside means the dog is to physically live at the address on the Certificate of Registration. The term 'exhibitor' means owner/s, as recorded on the Certificate of Registration.

INELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE

All Events Committee Members and any other individual closely involved with the Competition or closely associated with persons involved with the Competition shall be excluded from entering at the discretion of the Events Committee. Sponsors are eligible to enter at the discretion of the Events Committee.

The decision if any person and/or exhibit should be excluded is to be decided upon the facts of each case with the final arbiter being the Events Committee.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

The following eligibility requirements must be adhered to:

1. If an entrant has ownership transferred during the Competition period, its results remain valid if the ownership of the dog remains valid (Refer to Eligibility to Compete) and providing the exhibit continues to reside in Queensland.
2. Any exhibit leased/transferred out of Queensland during the Competition period, or any exhibitor who moves Interstate or Overseas during the Competition period, automatically loses all entitlements to compete in the Competition.
3. All fees paid by an Exhibitor to enter in the Competition (including fees paid by an Exhibitor who falls under General Requirements 2), will not be refunded.
4. Any exhibitor who transfers to Queensland, permanently, from another Country / State will be eligible to compete:
 - (i) providing they join and/or hold current membership of Dogs Queensland:
 - a) at their permanent address in Queensland; and
 - b) during the eligibility period and is prior to and includes the end date of the eligibility period (Refer to General Rules 1).
 - (ii) providing the exhibit is transferred to that Queensland address and resides there, referred to in (i), for the majority of the eligibility period (majority referring to more than half of the time of the eligibility period).

QUALIFICATION FOR ENTRY AS A FINALIST

1. For the Dog of the Year Competition an exhibit over the age of 6 (six) months is required to be awarded a minimum of 1 (one) Best in Show at any All Breeds Championship Show, Agricultural Show, Group / Multi Breed Championship Show where a Best in Show is awarded, or a Breed / Multi Breed Specialty Championship Show held in Queensland during the qualifying period (Refer General Rules 1).
2. To enter the Final, exhibitors will register their exhibit for a fee of \$50 per exhibit through Show Manager prior to the advertised closing date, 7th January 2027. Late entries received after the closing date, 7th January 2027 and up to and including 14th January 2027 the entry fee will be \$70 per exhibit through Show Manager.
3. All rules under the General Rules apply.
4. For cataloguing purposes, the following is required of the qualifying exhibit by 14th January 2027 and to be submitted through Show Manager:
 - (i) Photocopy of the Exhibits registration
 - (ii) Owners Name
 - (iii) Breed of exhibit
 - (iv) Date of birth of exhibit
 - (v) Name and date of the qualifying show.

Note:

The Events Committee reserves all rights to include or exclude an exhibit which they feel does or does not meet any of the criteria listed within these Rules.

The Dog of the Year Event will be run in accordance with the rules and regulations of Dogs Queensland.

However, given the contrasting nature of the event to that of a normal Conformation Show, the rules can be subject to change in exceptional circumstances, at the Events Committee's discretion.

GENERAL RULES

1. The Queensland Puppy of the Year Competition will be sponsored, promoted and run by Dogs Queensland, commencing on Thursday, 1st January 2026 and ending on Thursday, 31st December 2026.
2. The Puppy of the Year Final will be judged on Friday evening, 5th February 2027.
3. In the event that a cash prize is awarded for the Competition, the prize will be awarded in the name of the Queensland resident owner/s of the winning exhibit. Where an exhibit is held in joint ownership with a current financial member of the ANKC, that member must be financial as of 1st January 2026 up to and including 5th February 2027.
4. Finalists in the competition will receive a memento from the Events Committee.
5. Catalogues for the Competition will be available for a fee.
6. The Committee is authorised to take steps to verify the eligibility of Competition finalists. Should an exhibitor or exhibit not meet all the specific criteria for eligibility, the exhibit in question will not be permitted to compete in the Competition Final.
7. The Events Committee reserves the right to alter any Competition rules should it be deemed necessary.
8. The Dogs Queensland Board of Directors is the final arbiter of disputed issues in respect to this Competition and exhibitors acknowledge that, by entering this Competition, they agree to be bound by the Rules and they further agree to indemnify Dogs Queensland against all claims arising from any actions associated with this Competition.

ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE

In order to qualify for Puppy of the Year, the exhibit must reside in the State of Queensland from 1st January 2026 or born during 2026 and reside in the State of Queensland and must remain resident in the State until the Competition date, 5th February 2027.

The exhibit must be registered to a Dogs Queensland member either solely or in partnership during this period (General Rules 3).

To reside means the dog is to physically live at the address on the Certificate of Registration. The term 'exhibitor' means owner/s, as recorded on the Certificate of Registration.

INELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE

2. To enter the Final, exhibitors will register their exhibit for a fee of \$50 per exhibit through Show Manager prior to the advertised closing date, 7th January 2027. Late entries received after the closing date, 7th January 2027 and up to and including 14th January 2027 the entry fee will be \$70 per exhibit through Show Manager.
3. All rules under the General Rules apply.
4. For cataloguing purposes, the following is required of the qualifying exhibit by 14th January 2027 and to be submitted through Show Manager:
 - (i) Photocopy of the Exhibits registration
 - (ii) Owners Name
 - (iii) Breed of exhibit
 - (iv) Date of birth of exhibit

RULES FOR THE CONDUCT OF QUEENSLAND NEUTER OF THE YEAR COMPETITION IN 2026

GENERAL RULES

1. The Queensland Neuter of the Year Competition will be sponsored, promoted and run by Dogs Queensland, commencing on Thursday, 1st January 2026 and ending on Thursday, 31st December 2026.
2. The Neuter of the Year Final will be judged on Saturday evening, 6th February 2027.
3. In the event that a cash prize is awarded for the Competition, the prize will be awarded in the name of the Queensland resident owner/s of the winning exhibit. Where an exhibit is held in joint ownership with a current financial member of the ANKC, that member must be financial as of 1st January 2026 up to and including 6th February 2027.
4. Finalists in the competition will receive a memento from the Events Committee.
5. Catalogues for the Competition will be available for a fee.
6. The Committee is authorised to take steps to verify the eligibility of Competition finalists. Should an exhibitor or exhibit not meet all the specific criteria for eligibility, the exhibit in question will not be permitted to compete in the Competition Final.
7. The Events Committee reserves the right to alter any Competition rules should it be deemed necessary.
8. The Dogs Queensland Board of Directors is the final arbiter of disputed issues in respect to this Competition and exhibitors acknowledge that, by entering this Competition, they agree to be bound by the Rules and they further agree to indemnify Dogs Queensland against all claims arising from any actions associated with this Competition.

ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE

In order to qualify for Neuter of the Year, the exhibit must reside in the State of Queensland from 1st January 2026 or born during 2026 and reside in the State of Queensland and must remain resident in the State until the Competition date, 6th February 2027.

The exhibit must be registered to a Dogs Queensland member either solely or in partnership during this period (General Rules 3).

To reside means the dog is to physically live at the address on the Certificate of Registration. The term 'exhibitor' means owner/s, as recorded on the Certificate of Registration.

INELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE

All Events Committee Members and any other individual closely involved with the Competition or closely associated with persons involved with the Competition shall be excluded from entering at the discretion of the Events Committee. 2. To enter the Final, exhibitors will register their exhibit for a fee of \$50 per exhibit through Show Manager prior to the advertised closing date, 7th January 2027. Late entries received after the closing date, 7th January 2027 and up to and including 14th January 2027 the entry fee will be \$70 per exhibit through Show Manager.
3. All rules under the General Rules apply.
4. For cataloguing purposes, the following is required of the qualifying exhibit by 14th January 2027 and to be submitted through Show Manager:
 - (i) Photocopy of the Exhibits registration
 - (ii) Owners Name
 - (iii) Breed of exhibit
 - (iv) Date of birth of exhibit

RULE 21 – OBLIGATION TO REGISTER

- 21.1 A member who breeds a litter of dogs, the parents of which are registered or eligible for registration with the CCCQ Ltd or other recognised canine controlling body must:
- (1) Register such litter, including all of the living progeny in such litter at one (1) and the same time within eighteen (18) calendar months of the date of whelping or prior to sale or rehoming (see Rule 28). No litter will be registered after twelve (12) months of age without the approval of the CCCQ Ltd;
 - (2) Comply with CCCQ Ltd Rules and correctly complete all forms required by the CCCQ Ltd;
 - (3) Pay such fees as are determined from time to time by the CCCQ Ltd. A standard fee will be set for registrations received by the office on a date within four (4) months of the date of whelping and a higher fee for registrations received by the office on a date between four (4) and six (6) months or between six (6) and twelve (12) months of the date of whelping;
 - (4) Where the breeder wishes to register a puppy with the breeder's name as part owner, an Agreement signed by the purchaser of the puppy is to be attached to the application to register the litter. Only official CCCQ Ltd Partnership Agreement forms are to be used;
 - (5) Where the breeder wishes to register a puppy on the Limited Register, an Official CCCQ Ltd Limited Register Agreement statement from the purchaser stating that the implications of the Limited Register are understood is to be attached to the application; and
 - (6) A breeder may, at time of registration on the General Register, endorse registration "Not to be exported".

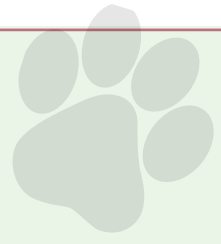

Breeder Alert – Puppy Scam Websites

Dogs Queensland has become increasingly aware of Puppy Scam Websites using legitimate Dogs Queensland Registration and Queensland Breeder Identification (BIN) Numbers to sell puppies. Dogs Queensland Registration Numbers are obtained from legitimate websites such as Dogs Queensland or DogzOnline, where they are displayed as required by the Queensland Government.



Please see the [Queensland Dog Breeder Fact Sheets](#) for regulations and guidelines for Queensland Dog Breeders.

An example of a typical scam is:

- A Dogs Queensland Membership number is lifted from current advertising on the internet.
- The scammer researches and obtains personal details of the breeder including name, suburb, prefix.
- A domain name similar to the Kennel prefix is registered on an offshore registry.
- Once the breeder has ceased advertising the litter of puppies a new website is published.
- No physical address or phone numbers are advertised on the website.
- The seller avoids permitting you to physically see the cyber puppy and only sends non genuine pictures.
- The seller insists on only accepting payment by a crypto currency or a funds transfer.

As a breeder what can you do to avoid being an unknowing victim of a Puppy Scam:

- Regularly Google search the internet for websites using a similar Domain Name as your Prefix.
- Put a warning notification in your online advertising to alert buyers to check any website they are looking at is legitimate.
- Encourage puppy buyers to verify breeder information with Dogs Queensland and make direct in-person contact with you.
- Ensure puppy buyers check communications are made with verified contact details.
- Encourage puppy buyers to meet the puppy and breeder before handing over payments.

As a buyer what can you do to avoid being a victim of a Puppy Scam:

- Verify breeder information with Dogs Queensland.
- Ensure communications are made to verified contact details.
- Meet the puppy and breeder before handing over payments.
- If paying online, use a credit card or PayPal where you have a degree of buyer protection.
- Check website is an established site with a website security certificate.
- Avoid websites without physical address or phone numbers.
- Ask for proof, including ANKC registration papers and veterinary health records for any puppy.

TIBETAN TERRIER

An intelligent breed, the Tibetan Terrier can be sensitive, loving and mischievous, as well as independent, aloof and compassionate, often with a sense of humour.

Originating in the isolated Himalayan country of Tibet, Tibetan Terriers were historically kept as watchdogs, herding dogs, and good luck charms, and are often called the “Holy Dog of Tibet” as they were also highly valued companions to the Lamas in the monasteries, where they were bred for over 2,000 years. They were also used to retrieve articles that fell down mountainsides.

The country of Tibet, “The Roof of the World”, is the highest region on earth with an average elevation of 4,380 metres. Mount Kosciusko stands at 2,228 metres. With a bleak, desolate and rugged environment, the Tibetan Terrier has adapted to survive the extremes of altitude, temperature, and terrain to become a sturdy, well balanced, sure footed and agile dog.

In 1922, Dr Agnes Greig, an English surgeon practising medicine in northern India, was given a female Tibetan Terrier puppy in gratitude for saving a Tibetan woman’s life. Dr Greig subsequently obtained a male, and the first litter outside of Tibet was born in 1924 and registered as Lhasa Terriers. After presenting three generations to judges and the India Kennel Club, the breed was recognised in India and the name changed to Tibetan Terrier in 1930.

The Tibetan Terrier was recognised by the Kennel Club (England) in 1937, and the first Challenge Certificate in the breed was awarded at Crufts in 1938. The FCI definitively accepted the Tibetan Terrier in 1957. The American Kennel Club accepted the Tibetan Terrier into the Non-Sporting group in 1973.

In England the breed gained popularity due to their size, good nature, loyalty, and many engaging ways. It was therefore the dedicated English breeders and owners who have maintained and developed the breed in keeping with its historical purpose. The most notable awards by a Tibetan Terrier were in 2007 where Eng. Ch. Araki Fabulous Willy won Best in Show at Crufts, and in 2018 Am/Ch. Ecco Domani’s The Guardian of Destiny was Runner Up Best in Show at Sydney Royal.

The Tibetan Terrier is not a Terrier in the true sense of the word, a dog bred to go to ground after vermin, but named so due to its resemblance of

the medium sized terrier dogs.

The requirements in the breed standard for the Tibetan Terrier reflect his origin and purpose, as well as the need for his survival in an inhospitable environment, despite there being a few amendments since the original breed standard was published by the Tibetan Breeds Association in 1934.

The General Appearance of the Tibetan Terrier is one of a sturdy, medium sized, profusely double coated and generally square dog, who is balanced and without exaggeration. His sturdiness being essential to be able to survive the harsh environment without compromising his ability to navigate the often treacherous terrain. The Tibetan Terrier stands between 36 and 41cms at the wither and generally weighs between 8 and 14 kg.

With extremes of weather in Tibet, very low-density air and high ultraviolet radiation due to the high altitude, the Tibetan Terrier needs to have the protection of his long profuse double coat and black facial pigment. His head is medium in size, with a marked stop, and in balance with the whole dog. The eyes are large and dark, and well protected by the heavy coat falling forward over

them, with eyelashes to give a lift and prevent the coat from falling into the eyes. It should be noted that the ANKC breed standard calls for the hair to “not affect the dog’s ability to see”. The nostrils should be large enough to obtain a good intake of air. The ears are pendant, small, and heavily feathered. The whole appearance of the head should give a resolute or bold and loyal expression.

The Tibetan Terrier has a strong muscular and medium length neck to allow the dog to carry his head above the level of the back blending well into the shoulders. The shoulders are well laid with good length and slope of upper arm, and a slightly sloping pastern. When viewed from the front, the forelegs are straight. The distance from wither to elbow equals the distance from elbow to ground. The entire front assembly should be strong, muscular, and well-formed, without being heavy or loaded, as it is the shock absorber to withstand the stresses incurred in the unforgiving native environment.

The body of the Tibetan Terrier is well muscled, compact and powerful, but not so cobby and

condensed to limit its agility. The rib cage is oval in shape to permit free action of the forequarters, with ample room for the lungs and heart, the ribs should extend well back to a short, strong loin. The deep chest should extend to the elbows, and the prosternum, although not mentioned in any breed standard, should be moderate. Again, these are the requirements of the native environment which demanded a high standard of performance, in a high altitude, for a minimum of effort, and on a frugal diet.

The hindquarters are required to be the driving force of the Tibetan Terrier, propelling him across the rugged terrain, which often included risky leaps and bounds from rocky and unforgiving mountainsides, as he travelled with the Tibetan nomads and their herds of livestock. Capable of exerting tremendous leverage, the hindquarters are strong and muscular, with well bent stifles and low set, parallel, strong hocks without any sign of exaggeration.

The most unique feature of the Tibetan Terrier is his feet. The feet are large, round and have

no arch, standing well down on the pads. The American breed standard is more explicit in the description, stating, *“They are large round and flat in shape producing a snowshoe effect that provides traction. The pads are thick and strong.”*

There is no other breed which has a flat foot, which is round and as large as the Tibetan Terrier has in relative proportion to the size of the dog. However, to accommodate thick tough pads, the bones cannot lie 100% flat. The flat look is emphasized by the sloping pasterns, which are responsible for the breeds typical stance – “well down on its pads” The Tibetan Terrier should stand with its weight on the midfoot. The roundness of the foot is to provide toe grip on mountainsides and to prevent sinking into soft snow. The thick tough pads assist to act as a cushion when jumping.

The tail is medium length, very well feathered, set on fairly high, and carried in a gay curl over the back. Occasionally there will be a kink at the end, which is permissible and the tail may sit on the back line or fall to either side of the hip.

The culmination of the structural requirements of the Tibetan Terrier result in a gait which is powerful, co-ordinated, and economical, and should portray the ability to be agile. The stride is effortless, with good reach in the fore and powerful drive from the rear, whilst maintaining a level backline and an alert head carriage. These attributes are key to the ability of the Tibetan Terrier to navigate the plateaus and mountainous regions of Tibet in a rarified atmosphere.

One of the most intriguing aspects of the Tibetan Terrier is his colour. The Tibetan Terrier can be any colour or combination of colours in any pattern. Dilution factor can present as a dog matures and this is perfectly acceptable. The only exception in colour is chocolate, liver and merle as these colours do not have the required black pigment on the eye rims and nose.

The coat of the Tibetan Terrier is a long double coat, profuse and either wavy or straight, with a fine woolly undercoat. Regular brushing and grooming is required to maintain the coat and to prevent matting. Dogs that are not competing in





the show ring may be clipped down to a puppy cut to minimise the time spent grooming.

In all, the Tibetan Terrier is a hardy breed, generally living to between 12 and 16 years of age. However, like many breeds, pure bred and cross bred, there are some hereditary health issues that may occur within the Tibetan Terrier.

DNA testing is available for the following conditions:

Eyes: Primary Lens Luxation, Progressive Retinal Atrophy, Rod Cone Degeneration

Neurological: Neuronal Ceroid Lipofuscinosis

Other conditions that may occur in the Tibetan Terrier are Hip Dysplasia, Patella Luxation, and Cataracts.

As a companion animal, the Tibetan Terrier often has a nature and personality that is unique to his person or family. They are suited to family life generally with or without older children and often having a more profound bond with one person in the family. They are adaptable to many lifestyles including apartments, homes and rural living.

An intelligent breed, the Tibetan Terrier can be sensitive, loving and mischievous, as well as

independent, aloof and compassionate, often with a sense of humour. Intelligence is not always directly correlated to obedience, so it is important to instil consistent reward-based training. The compassionate side of their nature and medium size also lends the Tibetan Terrier to being an excellent support or therapy dog.

Tibetan Terriers are versatile athletes, and naturally suited to various dog sports, due to their sure-footedness and agility. Together with the desire to please and enjoy life with their person, the Tibetan Terrier may excel in Agility, Herding, Scent Work and Trick Dog sports.

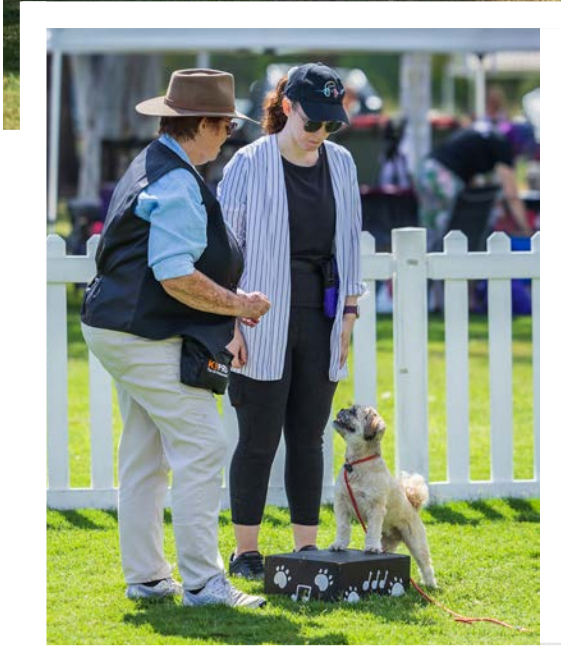
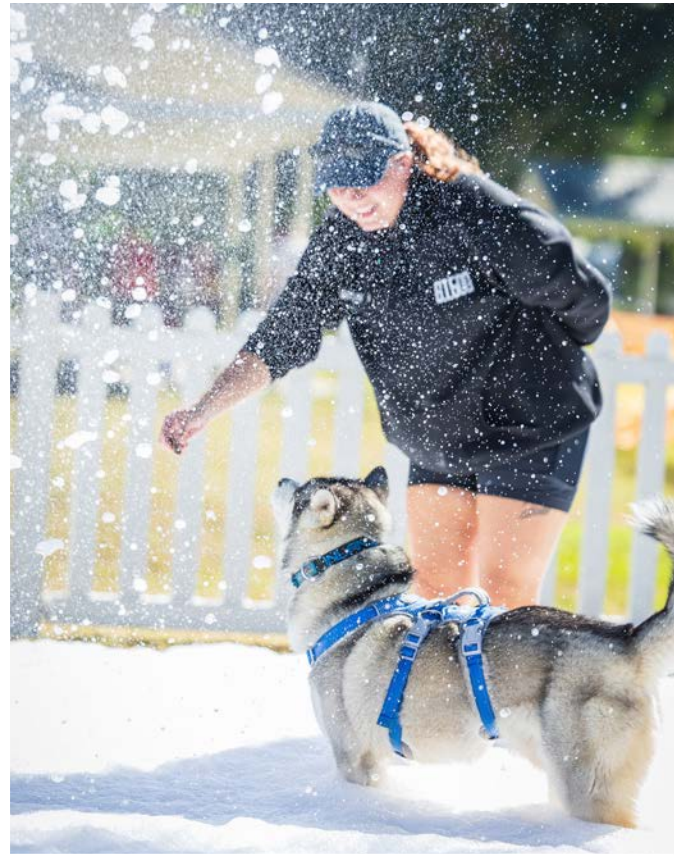
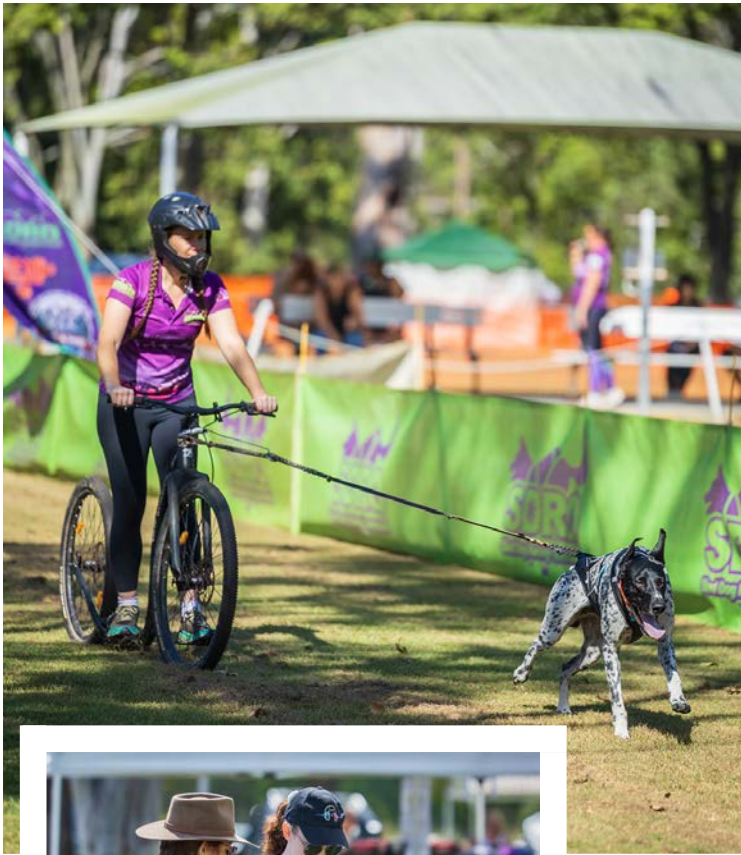
Looking Ahead

We look forward to building on this momentum and hope to see even more clubs participating in 2027.

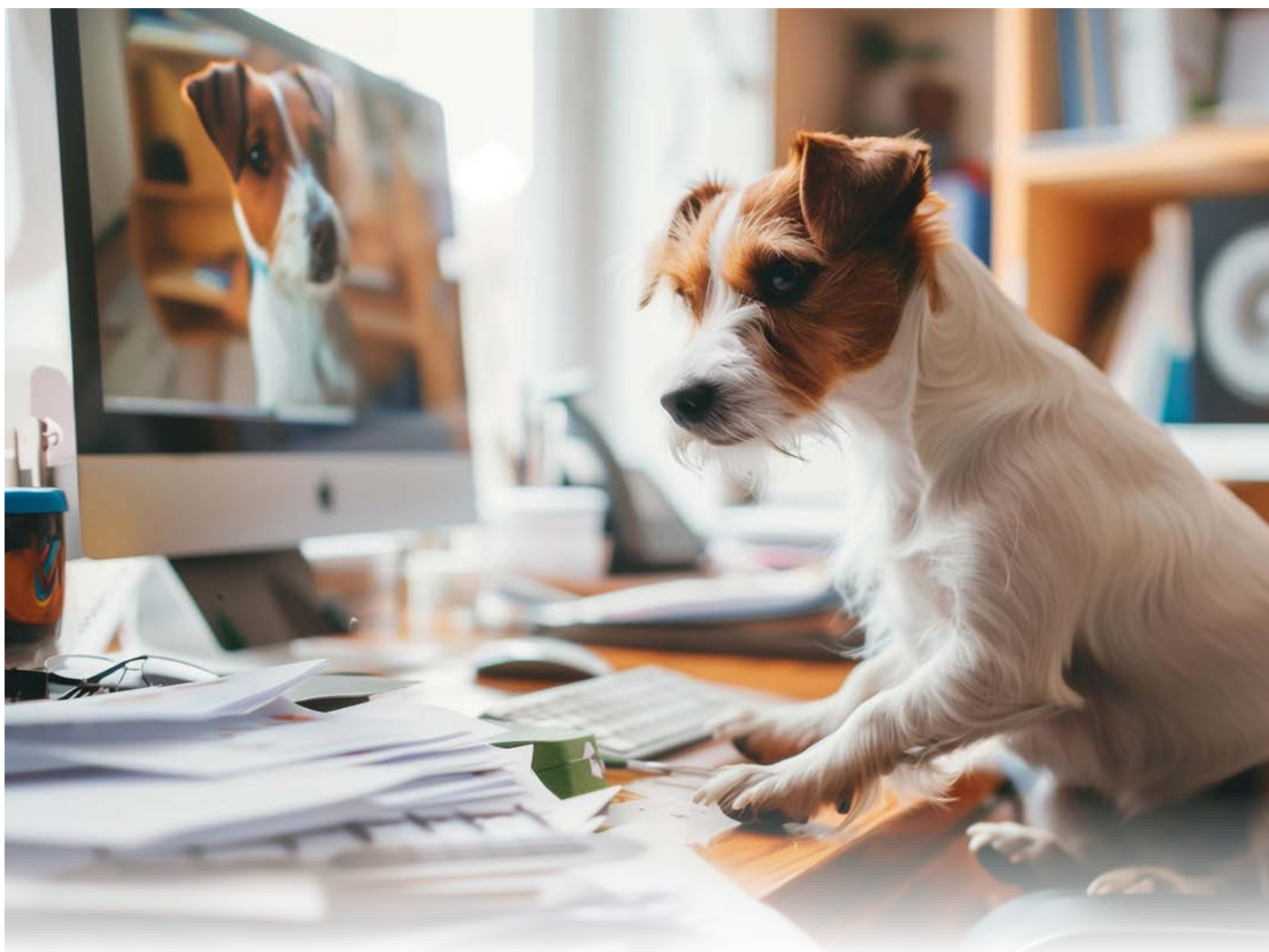

Club Annual Reports

Gordon Mayne

– *Chair, Constitution and Rules Committee*

Clubs are required to submit an annual report to Dogs Queensland within one month of their annual general meeting (AGM). This report demonstrates the club's sustainability and that it is well managed. Another key element is updating to club contacts.

The club annual report form template is available on the Dogs Queensland website:

dogsqueensland.org.au/clubs/club-forms/

Clubs incorporated under the *Associations Incorporation Act 1981* (the Act) will have additional reporting requirements as defined by the Office of Fair Trading.

The annual general meeting

All clubs must hold an AGM within six months of the end of the club's financial year. The financial year will be defined in the club's constitution/

rules of association. The club's constitution/rules of association will also detail what business must occur at the AGM, how notice is given to members, and the process for the election of the management committee and officer bearers.

The club constitution/rules of association

The first point of reference on governance matters is always the club's constitution/rules of association. The club constitution/rules of association form a contract between the members and club and describes how the management committee shall run the club on behalf of its members. Similarly, it details members' rights and obligations.


All members of the management committee must be familiar with the club's constitution/rules of association. The President and Secretary should have a high level of understanding.



Many clubs are operating under constitutions/rules of association that date back as far as 1994. Clubs are recommended to adopt the Dogs Queensland Model Rules of Association to bring the club in alignment with contemporary club governance and for incorporated clubs to comply with new obligations under the Act. Information about adopting the Model Rules is available on the Dogs Queensland website:


dogsqueensland.org.au/clubs/new-model-rules/

Dogs Queensland is available to assist clubs to adopt the Dogs Queensland Model Rules of Association.

 **Tip:** It is good practice to review the club's constitution/rules of association at least every five years, and update if necessary.

The management committee


All clubs must have a management committee which is responsible for running the club on behalf of, and in the best interests of, its members. The size and membership of the committee is defined in club's constitution/rules of association.

 **Tip:** The Act defines the roles of President, Secretary and Treasurer as three distinct roles, therefore these roles should not be shared, you need three different people to fill these roles.

The Management Committee needs to meet at least every three months, more often if necessary. Meetings can be held in person or using technology (e.g. Zoom). All people attending the meeting must be able to hear and participate in discussions, in real time.

 **Tip:** Text messages, chat groups or emails may be used for discussion, planning and resolving urgent issues. Any decisions made in

these types for forums must be ratified at the next Management Committee meeting and recorded in the minutes.

Record keeping

The minutes of a Management Committee meeting provide a record of the deliberations and decisions made by the Management Committee. These are critical pieces of evidence should something go awry.


Minutes should include as a minimum:

- Name of the club in full
- Location of the meeting
- Date, start time and finish time
- Names of people present and any apologies.
- Confirmation of the previous meeting's minutes
- Follow up on business arising from previous meetings (business arising or action items)
- Tabling and accepting the Financial Reports (e.g. bank reconciliation, profit and loss statements, balance sheet)
- Approve any payments made or to be made (make sure details are recorded in the minutes)
- Any new business making sure details of decisions are recorded in the minutes.

Audit requirements

The Board of Directors recognises the risks related to financial management of club affairs, and the importance of good financial management at club level. To reduce this risk, DQ has imposed a lower threshold for financial audit requirements (as defined in Appendix 2 of the Rules). These requirements apply to all clubs whether unincorporated or incorporated.

Total revenue is the total income during the last financial year before any expenses are deducted.


 **Tip:** Many clubs have more than one bank account; an operating account and a savings/investment account. Transfers between two bank accounts is not an income or expense and should not appear on the profit and loss statement. Instead, it is recorded on the balance sheet. For detailed information contact the club's auditor or accountant.



Current assets are any assets easily converted into cash, such as:


- cash, including in bank accounts
- shares
- accounts receivable
- short-term investments.

Property or any depreciable assets, for example, equipment or machinery, aren't included in current assets.

 **Tip:** Start planning and preparing for the club audit at least one month prior to the end of the financial year.

Level 1 – Large clubs

The club has current assets or total revenue equal to or greater than \$100,000 in the reportable financial year. The club must have an audit completed by a certified accountant or a registered auditor. The audit report must be tabled at the AGM.


 **Example:** A club with \$125,000 in the bank (including all bank accounts) and revenue of \$35,000 is a level 1 large club and requires a full audit.

Level 2 – Medium clubs

The club has current assets or total revenue exceeding \$20,000, but less than \$100,000 in the reportable financial year. The club must have an audit or verification statement completed by an accountant or a qualified auditor. The audit report or verification statement must be tabled at the AGM.

An example verification statement from an auditor or account is:


I have examined the club's/association's financial records and state that the club's/association's financial records show the club/association has adequate bookkeeping processes in place to correctly record and explain transactions to enable a true and fair financial statement to be prepared.

 **Example:** A club with a bank balance of \$23,000 and revenue of \$12,000 is a medium sized club. Or, if the figures were reversed, a bank balance of \$12,000 and revenue of \$23,000 is also a level 2 medium sized club.

Level 3 – Small clubs

A small club is defined as a club with current assets and total revenue less than \$20,000 in the reportable financial year. To be a small club, both criteria must be met. The club's financial statements must be verified by the association's President or Treasurer. The president or treasurer will need to verify your financial statements and provide this signed written statement:

The club's/association's financial records show the club/association keeps adequate financial records that correctly record and explain transactions and enable a true and fair financial statement to be prepared.

 **Example:** If the club has a bank balance of \$15,000 and revenue of \$19,000, the club is a level 1 small club.

Selecting a person to complete the audit or verification statement

For Level 1 and Level 2 clubs where an audit or verification statement is required, the following considerations apply when appointing an auditor or verifier.

A registered auditor can audit or verify the clubs' financial records if they hold a valid registration with the Australian Securities and Investments Commission (ASIC) as a company auditor under the *Corporations Act 2001*.

A certified accountant must be a certified member of one of the following organisations to be eligible to audit the club's financial records:

- CPA Australia—they will use the letters CPA or FCPA after their name
- Chartered Accountants Australia and New Zealand—using the letters CA or FCA
- the Institute of Public Accountants—using the letters MIPA or FIPA

Level 2 sized clubs who are incorporated associations can apply to the Office of Fair Trading to have their financial reports audited/verified by a person who is not a registered auditor or certified accountant. Be mindful that the approval process could delay the audit/verification process.

Your auditor or verifier can't be:

- the secretary or a member of the club's management committee
- an employee of the club
- a business partner, employer or employee of a committee member
- a spouse, relative or dependent of any of the above.

Dogs Queensland Annual Report Submission

The following reports must be submitted to DQ within one month after the AGM.

Annual report cover sheet. Complete and sign the annual report cover sheet. Ensure you include dates and attendance for management committee meetings and general meetings. Ensure the report is signed as required.

Minutes of the AGM. A copy of the minutes from the AGM, signed by the President.

Presidents report. A copy of the Present's report as tabled at the AGM.

Audit report or verification statement. A copy of the signed audit report or verification statement which was tabled at the AGM.

Balance Sheet. The audited balance sheet tabled at the AGM which details the club's assets and liabilities at the close of the financial year.

Income and expenditure statement. Also referred to as a profit and loss statement. The statement must clearly break down income and expenses, for example (not an exclusive list), membership

fees, entry fees, donations, canteen, raffles, judges travel, Dogs Queensland levies.

Exhibition income and expenditure statement. Also referred to as a profit and loss statement. The statement should clearly break down income and expenses related to club exhibitions (shows and trials). This is an important tool which can be used by clubs to identify fundraising needs to ensure exhibitions are sustainable.

Register of members. A register of all members which shows names and addresses as at the date of the end of the club's financial year. The register must be signed by the President and Secretary verifying it is accurate.

Office bearer details. Details of the members of the club's management committee as elected at the AGM. The list must also include contact details of the Show and/or Trial Secretary, if these positions are not on the management committee. Add an additional sheet if necessary.

Other reports. Copies of any other reports tabled at the AGM.

A note on incorporation under the Associations Incorporation Act 1981

Dogs Queensland encourages clubs to become incorporated under the Act. Incorporation provides several key benefits, offering legal recognition and structure that enhances stability and good governance.

By becoming an incorporated association, the club becomes a separate legal identity, meaning it can enter contracts, own property, and be liable for its debts independently of its members. This separation protects members and officeholders from personal liability, safeguarding their personal assets from potential financial risks associated with



dispute resolution, and decision-making, which promotes accountability and transparency. As a legally recognised entity, the club can also access grants, funding opportunities, and other resources that are often unavailable to unincorporated groups.

Dogs Queensland is available to assist clubs transition to incorporation.

The Constitution and Rules Committee is also available to provide advice on rule interpretation and support to clubs

the club's operations. Additionally, incorporation provides a clear framework for management, including requirements for financial reporting,

regarding administrative and governance matters. The Committee can be contacted via the Dogs Queensland office.

Bite Prevention In The Home

- Keeping children safe around dogs this winter

As the temperatures drop, our dogs naturally spend more time indoors – curled up on beds, sharing lounge space, and becoming more integrated into daily family life. While this is one of the great joys of dog ownership, it also brings an important consideration: increased proximity between dogs and children can increase the risk of dog bites.

The good news? Most bites are preventable. With the right education, supervision, and

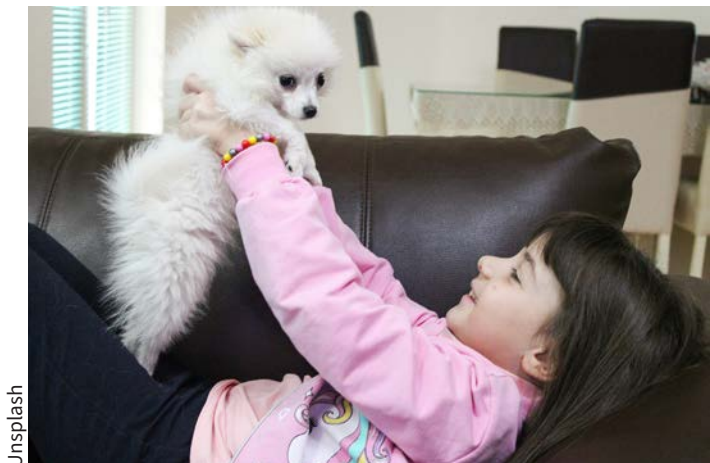
understanding of dog behaviour, families can create safe and positive interactions between children and dogs.

UNDERSTANDING WHERE AND WHY BITES HAPPEN

Research consistently shows that most serious dog bites occur in the home, not in public places. This is particularly important for families, as it challenges the common assumption that unfamiliar dogs pose the greatest risk.



Children are among the most vulnerable. Studies highlight that young children are at a higher risk of more severe bites, especially when interactions are unsupervised.

Why does this happen?

- Dogs may feel **trapped or overwhelmed indoors**
- Children may unknowingly invade a **dog's space**
- Familiarity can lead to **reduced caution and supervision**
- Dogs communicate discomfort subtly – and these signals are often missed

DOGS DON'T "BITE OUT OF NOWHERE"

One of the most important messages for families is this:

Dogs communicate before they bite.

That explains that most bites follow a predictable escalation:

- **Level 1:** Body freezes, whale eyes, lip licking or yawning, shifting positions (warning signs)

- **Level 2:** Growling, barking, air snaps, lunging
- **Level 3:** Teeth touch skin, no puncture
- **Level 4+:** Increasing severity, including punctures and multiple bites

These early warning signs are critical. A growl is not “bad behaviour”—it is a dog clearly saying: **“I’m uncomfortable. Please give me space.”**

When these warnings are ignored or punished, dogs may skip straight to biting in future situations.

THE WINTER FACTOR: WHY RISK INCREASES

During colder months, several changes occur:

- Dogs spend **more time in confined indoor spaces**
- There is less opportunity to retreat or avoid interaction
- Children are often home more (school holidays, indoor play)
- Shared spaces like couches and beds become high-value areas

This combination increases the likelihood of unintentional pressure on the dog, which can trigger defensive behaviour.

TOP BITE PREVENTION STRATEGIES FOR FAMILIES

1. Supervision is Non-Negotiable

Research strongly emphasises that children should always be supervised around dogs – even family pets.

- No supervision = no interaction
- This is especially critical for children under 10

2. Teach Children “Dog Rules” Early

Simple, consistent rules make a big difference:

- Don’t approach a dog that is sleeping, eating, or resting
- Don’t hug, climb on, or lie on dogs
- Don’t take toys or food away
- Always let the dog come to you

Think of it as teaching children respect for space, just like we do with people.

3. Give Dogs a Safe Space

Every dog should have a child-free retreat area, such as:

- A crate

- A bed in a quiet corner
- A separate room

Children should be taught:
“When the dog is here, we leave them alone.”

4. Learn to Recognise Early Warning Signs

Common signs a dog is uncomfortable include:

- Turning head away
- Lip licking or yawning
- Stiff body posture
- Growling or freezing

These are early intervention opportunities, not behaviours to punish.

5. Manage High-Risk Situations

Most bites occur during predictable situations:

- Food time

- Resting or sleeping
- Excitement or rough play
- When a dog is unwell or in pain

Proactively managing these moments significantly reduces risk.

6. Set Dogs Up for Success

Prevention isn't just about children – it's also about

supporting the dog:

- Provide regular exercise and mental stimulation

- Avoid overwhelming environments
- Ensure proper socialisation and training
- Seek professional advice if behavioural concerns arise

A SHARED RESPONSIBILITY

Dog bites are not just a public safety issue – they are also a welfare issue for dogs.

As highlighted in research, serious bite incidents often lead to rehoming or euthanasia of the dog involved.

Preventing bites protects:

- **Children**
- **Families**
- **The future of the dog**

FINAL THOUGHTS

Dogs are valued members of our families, and children benefit enormously from growing up with them. However, safe relationships don't happen by chance – they are built through:

- Education
- Supervision
- Respect for canine behaviour

As we head into the cooler months and welcome our dogs further into our homes, now is the perfect time to revisit these principles.

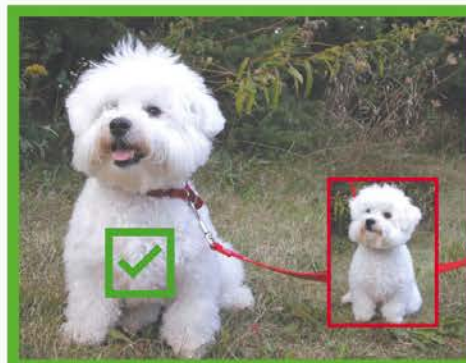

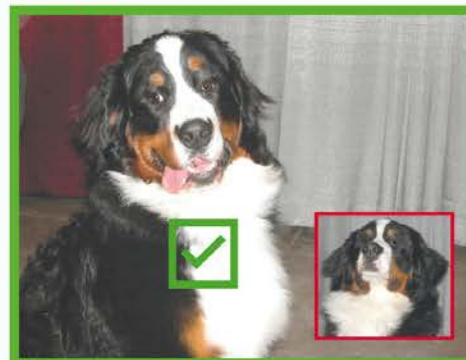

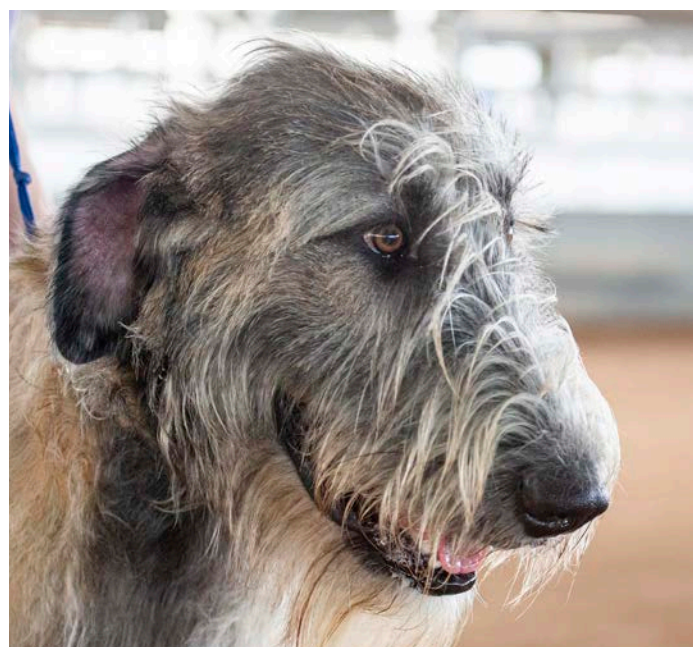

These outstanding events were proudly hosted by Director Tabitha Young, alongside Andrea Wohlhuter and the dedicated team from the Cairns Kennel Club.

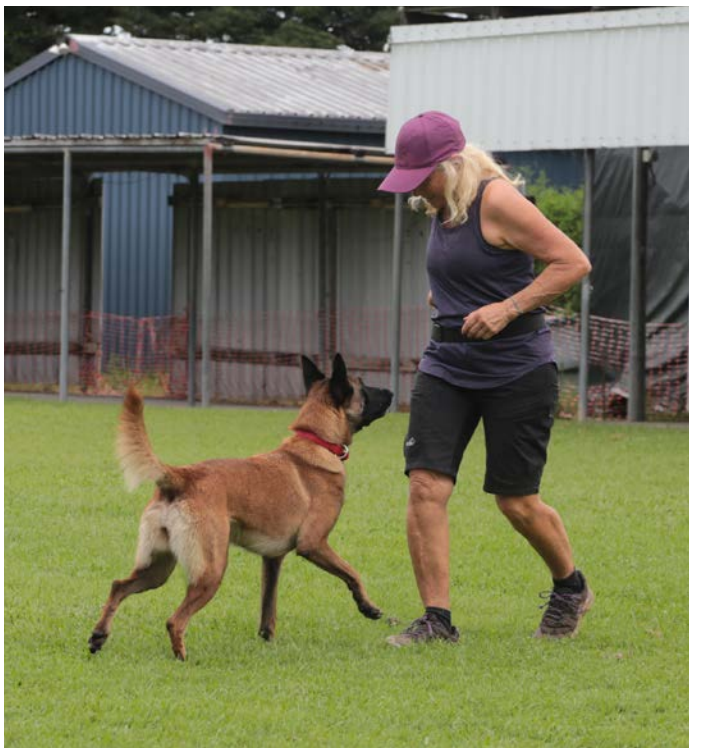

Easter saw Zone 2's great feature weekend at Bundaberg Canine Club's annual Easter celebration. Well done to the club driven by Margaret Rae Norton on another fantastic cluster of shows.

At first (with the fuel crisis and the current cost of living) it was expected that entries would not come to fruition but thanks to the support of our Dogs Queensland members from near and far, the result to the call out to come and be part of the shows was heard loud and clear and the members came forth and entered. The result, entries only slightly down on 2025 – congratulations to the club and the exhibitors for all your support and efforts!

The shows had great international judges that certainly brought their expertise to the ring, with stewards that ensured the days flowed as best as they could with the entries and format of each day. The committee sought excellent sponsorship and great prizing that the eventual

winners certainly appreciated.

MEMBERS SPOKE UP AT BUNDY:

Thanks again to the Bundaberg Canine Club's committee for allowing the Dogs Queensland Directors to pay a visit on Easter Saturday to hold a members' forum and have some great honest conversation about areas of interest and concern that members currently have and would like to be able to discuss and have addressed.

These member conversations are important to

the Board so that there is an appreciation of the members thoughts and sometimes frustrations on moving our organisation forward and meeting the needs of the members.

It is planned that these will happen in all Zones on a regular basis, so it was great to start Zone 2's chats in Bundy.

The Directors certainly gained great insights into



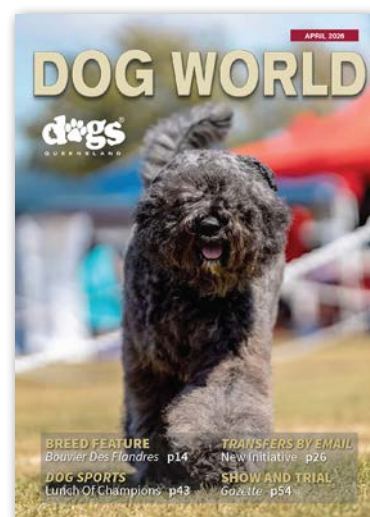
a number of areas of concern both at the forum and throughout the weekend with their ongoing chats with individual members and were also able to provide guidance in some areas whilst others will need more consideration from the Board as a whole.

There will be a review at Board level of the discussion that took place on the day and more feedback will be provided ... but for the interest of all members, the areas discussed in brief were:

- **Prizing from sponsors at shows** – Members were concerned that at some shows lately, sponsors were providing vouchers that were minimal return on a win at the show as the voucher was for low discounts on very expensive items. Clarity was given to those present that sponsored prizing is not part of the shows mandatory 20% of entry fees used on prizing but perhaps working with sponsors and requesting prizing that will return on an investment for them and provide the winner with a real sampling of their company's products. Some best practice discussion took place on how some clubs work with sponsors for both exhibitor, club and sponsors' benefit and that sharing some of these ideas would be ideal for all.
- **Mandatory closing dates for shows** – Club secretaries discussed their difficulties in closing shows so close to events and how that impacted firming up prize requirements based on entries and income received, notifying judges of their breed numbers and other factors. Members heard how late entries can effect clubs and some did not realise the impacts. It was noted that the mandatory 72 hour closing before a show rule did not stop a club closing earlier, even 7 days prior to a show. It was raised that how, with the cost of living and the ways of people's lives today, that this could dramatically effect a clubs entry the earlier they closed.
- **Financial transparency** – Members were not sure how some expenses, such as charges for various services, eg championships, litter registrations, etc were used and why the costs are at the level they are. The Directors present provided some guidance over staff wages, components of service charges that are paid to Dogs Australia, funds used to maintain the Dogs Queensland grounds

etc. Thus it is noted that transparency and strategic planning information is required to be shared more frequently with members and thus provide a greater understanding of the financial structure of our organisation.

- **Mandatory DNA testing of all puppies and breeding stock** – Members were appreciative of the recent proactive steps the board has taken to assist members to gain registrations of puppies and thus show young prospects, but there was a feeling that more could be done in this area. DNA providers were discussed, and options were discussed about puppies failing results and the difficulties from new pet owners to understand the requirements, urgencies and frustrations that breeders then bare. Thus, more review in this area will be sought by the Board with further information to come in this area.
- **Changes to Limited and Main Registration** – Members queried the new structure that Dogs Australia has alluded to with little consultation to the owners, breeders and members of the state bodies and how it may effect their breeding and registration options. Greater communication and information should be sought to provide to the members on this topic so that clarity is available to all.
- **Ways to communicate with members** – A discussion took place about information being disseminated to members. Dogs Queensland membership is diverse, from the age of members, diversity of working and non working life, time and lifestyle, and information absorbance methods. Paw Prints although is a great communication tool, it is often seen as information overload and thus not fully digestible. The use of click throughs for more information was suggested to shorten the length and allow members to quickly find the topics that interested

them most. Text messaging was considered for short important updates, the use of the app be researched as is underutilised, and the broader Dog World Journal was seen as the coffee table easy reader. Not one method suits all but a better way to use each may be a good start to a communication review.

- **Dogs owned by a kennel prefix** – Members asked why Queensland is the only state that does not allow a dog to be owned or registered under a kennel prefix. The Directors noted this and will bring to the Board for discussion and will provide more information in the near future.
- **Dogs Queensland grounds and development** – The members questioned that there seemed to be a lack of development of the members grounds over some considerable years and that long term planning seemed to be lacking or not being communicated. The Directors acknowledged the concerns of the members and discussed the short term intention to produce a strategic plan thus to highlight the best courses of action in managing and developing our grounds for the future needs of the members. This is a point that will take time but planning is underway and more consultation will be forthcoming.



Once again, thank you to my fellow Board members for coming up to Bundaberg, Tim Thomas, Duncan McAlister and Anslie Carius and supporting the Zone 2 and broader members that were present to ask questions, gain clarity and open up productive discussion amongst us all.

Till the next chat, let's still ask questions and seek better ways to make our canine world even more than what it presently is for all of us ...

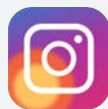
